Water scooter service launched in Dumboor

Dumboor Lake is one of the attractive tourist spots of the country. The government has taken initiative to embellish Narkel Kunja situated in the lake and the Tripura Tourism Development Corporation (TTDC) is also working towards grooming the tourist spots more. The programme was also attended by Mukhchhari ADC village committee's chairman Rangamala Chakma. the secretary of tourism department Kiran Gitte, and SDM of Karbook. Welcome address was given by

the director of tourism Ravel Hemendra Kumar.

Self Help Groups enlisted under Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission

Work for enlistment of Self Help Groups (SHGs) of different blocks in West district under Tripura Rural livelihood Mission (TRLM) is going on. Along with this, a scheme for formation of new SHGs has been taken up. A target has been taken to enlist 4217 old SHGs of the district under TRLM during the current financial year. 2737 SHGs have already been enlisted. Among them, 428 SHGs of Old Agartala block, 125 SHGs of Belbari block, 367 SHGs of Jirania block, 119 SHGs of Mandai block, 550 SHGs of Bamutia block, 475 SHGs of Mohanpur block, 86 SHGs of Lefunga block and 168 SHGs of Hejamara block have been enlisted under TRLM.

On the other hand, a target has been set for formation of 225 new SHGs in the district during this year. 38 new SHGs in Dukli block, 7 SHGs in Old Agartala block, 2 SHGs in Belbari block, 3 SHGs in Jirania block, 2 SHGs in Bamutia block, 6 SHGs in Mohanpur block and 6 SHGs in Lefunga block have been formed. West district

office of TRLM has informed that training on food processing, cultivation of fish, animal rearing etc under different schemes will be provided to the SHGs. After completion of the training, financial assistance will be provided for implementation of these schemes.

302046 mandays generated in Hejamara under MGNREGA

302046 mandays under MGNREGA scheme have been generated in Hejamara block during the current financial year. Under the scheme, renovation of road. construction of new road, land leveling, and digging of pond have been implemented. Moreover, toilets have been constructed for 1112 families under Swachch Bharat Mission (rural) during the current financial year. 469 toilets have been constructed till now. Construction of the remaining toilets is going on. Rs 12000 has been spent for construction of each toilet. Hejamara BDO office has informed this.

RCC bridge constructed under BAVP
