Subsidized power tiller for farmers in West district

West district agriculture and farmers' welfare office has provided power tillers to 201 farmers at a subsidized price of Rs. 85,000, harvesting machine to 10 farmers at a susidised price of Rs. 75,000, and weeding machines to 15 farmers at subsidized rate of Rs. 35,000.
