

100% Covid vaccination in Rangauti Gram Panchayat

As the two-day special vaccination drive for above 18 years is on, Rangauti Gram Panchayat area under Irani PHC reported 100% first dose Covid vaccination. The vaccination was completed on July 27 2021 in presence of Gram Panchayat chairperson Geeta Sukla Baidya and vice chairperson Narul Haq. Assistance to families in Jolaibari & Bogafa block under CMSPY

6,984 Beneficiary families of Jolaibari and Bogafa block under Santirbazar sub division will be given assistance under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in 2021-22 financial year with the initiative of agriculture and farmer's welfare department. Electric fan distribution under Bio village project

40 Beneficiary families were given 1 electric fan each yesterday under the initiative of Biotechnology department at Barkubari of Amtali Village Committee in Charilam block under Bio Village project spending Rs. 44,000. This was informed by Biotechnology department's senior scientific officer Anjan Sengupta.

Housing for 1,101 families in Dumburnagar and Raisyabari block

Houses are being built for 1 thousand 101 families of Dumburnagar and Raisyabari block of Gandacherra sub division under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana with the funds from 2019-20 financial year. Under this scheme, 670 families of Dumburnagar block received their first installment, 666 families received their second installment and 650 families received their third installment. So far houses for 650 families have been built in Dumburnagar block.

Remaining 20 houses are under construction. In Raisyabari block 431 families received their first installment, 430 families received their second installment and 427 families received their third installment. So far houses for 412 families have been built in Raishyabari block. Remaining 19 houses are under construction. 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees is being spent on building each house. This was informed from Dhalai DM & Collector office.

Assistance will be given for Fish business in Sepahijala district

21 Youths in Sepahijala district will be given cycles and ice boxes at 40% subsidy this year for trading in fish with the initiative of fisheries department, spending R. 5,400 on each beneficiary. Among these beneficiaries, 11 are from Sonamura and 10 are from Bishalgarh sub division. Apart from this, two beneficiaries each from Sonamura and Bishalgarh will be given 3-wheeler rickshaw and ice boxes on 60% subsidy spending Rs. 1.62 lakh on each beneficiary. Rs. 10,000 on each family will be invested. This was informed by deputy director of fisheries department, Sepahijala district, Kshitish Debbarma.
