

Mask Enforcement Day on Wednesday and Saturday

As the observance of Mask Enforcement Day has been successful in generating awareness among the people for wearing mask/ facecover and maintenance of social distance during the second wave of COVID-19, the state government has decided to observe “Mask Enforcement Days” on every Wednesday and Saturday till the spread of COVID-19 is successfully contained. On the enforcement day, apart from generation of awareness, the district and police administration will also impose penalties against the violators of the provisions of the “The Tripura Epidemic Disease, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020”. For this purpose, joint flying squads will be formed by the district administration involving police and volunteers that will move extensively for the enforcement. The fines imposed on these days will be reported at the end of the day to the office of the chief secretary. This has been informed by an order of the chief secretary.

TSECL introduces performance based incentives

With a view to motivating the employees working in Tripura State Electricity Corporation Limited (TSECL) for providing

better public service, Dr. M.S. Kele, MD of TSECL, has decided to introduce a performance based incentive scheme in the name of ‘Bidyut Seva Awards’. Under the scheme there will be 116 annual awards, of which 112 will be for individual employees and four awards will be for the best performing Circle, Division, Sub-division and Section offices with total financial implication of Rs. 20,00,000 every year, informed the TSECL corporate office.

The awards will be given in three categories namely Sarvottam Bidyut Seva Award, Ati Vishisht Bidhyut Seva Award, and Vishisht Bidyut Seva Award. The Sarvottam Bidyut Seva Award will consist of Rs. 25,000 cash, gold medal, citation and choice posting, Ati Vishisht Bidyut Seva Award will have Rs. 15,000 cash, silver medal, citation and choice posting and Vishisht Bidyut Seva Award will have Rs. 10,000 cash, bronze medal, citation and choice posting. In addition, the list of awardees along with their photos will be uploaded in the official website of TSECL as well as prominently displayed in different office of the Corporation. Twelve of the awards will be for executive employees and 24 for non-executive employees under each type of awards. Besides, there will be four MD awards for

individual employees for best leadership, best creative/ innovative works, best policy maker and best implementing officer.

5,871 Families get water connections in Dukli block

In the 2020-21 fiscal year, 5,871 families were given water connection under Atal Jaldhara Mission in Dukli block under Sadar sub division. Apart from this, 6 deep tube wells and 3 deep tubewells were dug for creating water source in the block. In the 2020-21 fiscal year, toilets were built for 691 families under Swachh Bharat Mission. Construction of community toilets for Belabor, Bagmara and Moloy Nagar Panchayat is in progress. This was informed by the Dukli Block Office.

Rs 18 lakh 75 thousand has been spent for this purpose. The programme was presided over by the Chairman of Tulashikhar Block Advisory Committee, Pradip Debbarma. Moreover, BDO of Tulashikhar Naba Kumar Jamatia and superintendent of agri-subdivision were also present in the programme.
