

## **JAGRUT TRIPURA to facilitate service delivery of welfare schemes**

JAGRUT TRIPURA App has been developed and launched in collaboration with EasyGov start-up to facilitate and give access to various welfare schemes of the government. The chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb launched the application and mobile App on March 2, 2021. Through this App citizens could know about their eligibility for different schemes and the process of availing their facilities. Director of IT Naresh Babu jhas informed this in a press release.

## **PM Kisan benefits to 29,904 farmers in Sepahijala during current FY**

Under the aegis of agriculture and farmers' welfare department till date 29,904 farmers have registered under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi in Sepahijala district during the current financial year. An amount of Rs. 6000 has been transferred to each of 29,126 farmers under the scheme. besides, survey is going on for 778 farmers.

Under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana hybrid paddy is being cultivated for demonstration purpose in 5,350 ha. area of Sepahijala district during the 2021-22

financial year. Rs. 9000 will be spent for each hectare land for this. Additionally 53 power tillers are being given to farmers at a subsidy of Rs. 85,000 and 72 pump sets are also being given at a subsidy of Rs. 10,000. Machine for making puffed rice is being given to 14 people with a subsidy of Rs. 1.40 lakh. In addition, paddy crusher machines are being given to 16 beneficiaries with a subsidy of Rs. 1.20 lakh.

On the other hand, sugar cane is being cultivated for demonstration purpose in 55 ha. area. In this, per ha. expenditure will be Rs. 20,000. Pea is being cultivated in 170 ha. area spending Rs. 9000 per ha. Maskalai dal is being cultivated in 445 ha. area spending Rs. 9000 per ha. Mustard is being cultivated in 60 ha. area in Rabi season spending Rs. 3000 per ha. Seeds and pesticide will also be provided to the farmers. This was informed by the deputy director of district agriculture and farmers' welfare department office.

## **7.64 lakh mandays generated in Manu & Chhamanu in current FY**

During the current financial year 7,64,333 mandays have been generated in Manu and Chhamanu block areas of Dhalai

district under MGNREGA. For this purpose an amount of Rs. 16,20,38,596 has been spent. Under the scheme 4,37,566 mandays have been generated only in Manu block spending Rs. 9,27,21,592 and 3,26,967 mandays have been generated in Chhamanu block spending Rs. 6,93,17,000. This information has been collected from the Dhalai DM office.

### **SRI paddy cultivation in Amarpur agri-subdivision areas**

High yielding and hybrid paddy has been cultivated in SRI system under different schemes in Amarpur agri-subdivision during the last financial year. Under RKBY hybrid Aman paddy was cultivated in 370 ha. area in this agri-subdivision. Rs. 9,000 has been spent on per hectare production. Through this 1,392 farmers have been benefitted. Under the National Food Security Mission also hybrid Aman paddy was cultivated in 140 ha. land at the cost of Rs. 9000 per ha. thereby benefitting 571 farmers.

In addition, under State Plan high yielding Aus paddy was cultivated in 10 ha. area and Aman paddy was cultivated in 210 ha. area. A total of 855 farmers have benefited from this. In this case per

hectare expenditure was Rs. 3,918. Besides, under RKBY Boro paddy has been cultivated in 1,066 ha. area thereby benefiting 3,832 farmers. Rs. 9,000 per ha. has been spent for this. Under National Food Security Mission spending Rs. 9000 per hectare hybrid Boro paddy was cultivated in 550 ha. area. Total 1,825 farmers have benefited from this. On the other hand, under State Plan hybrid Boro paddy was cultivated in 250 ha. area spending Rs. 3,918 per ha. Total 840 farmers have benefited from this, informed agriculture office Tushar Das.

### **Different social security pensions to 11,257 beneficiaries in Dukli**

In Dukli block 11,257 beneficiaries are getting social pensions from the social welfare and social education department. Among them, 1,167 beneficiaries are getting Rs. 500 each as female child pension. And 10,090 persons are getting Rs. 1000 each as pension of different schemes. Indira Gandhi National Disability Pension is going to 107 beneficiaries and Old Age Pension is going to 2,163 beneficiaries. Whereas, Indira Gandhi National Widow Pension is being given to 954 widows.
