

Inauguration of newly constructed concrete bridge over Deo river

One of the goals of the present government is to distribute the benefits of the government schemes to the marginalized people of the state. It is for this purpose that Prati Ghare Sushason campaign has been started in the state. In this campaign, access to government schemes and services will be ensured for the people of the state, said Chief Minister Prof. (Dr) Manik Saha after inaugurating the newly constructed bridge over Deo river on Gopalpur- Shivnagar Road in Laljuri block. Social Welfare and Social Education Minister Santana Chakma, MDC Shailendra Nath, Laljuri block BAC Chairman Ajoyanta Choudhury and officials of PWD were present in the inaugural programme. It is to be mentioned that rupees 3 crore 85 lakh 97 thousand 280 has been spent for construction of the bridge over Deo river.

Addressing the people there the Chief Minister stated that state government is working for the welfare of people under the guidance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The government is always implementing development programme with a positive outlook on public welfare. He said that the central government has recognised the success of State

Government in implementing plans in communication, education and health sectors of the state. State government has also made efforts to empower women in the State. The present Government is implementing development programs with specific plans. Produce of the farmers was destroyed due to unseasonal rainfall in the state. Rupees 7 crore 40 lakh has been paid to the affected 41,581 farmers of the state. CM launches State-Level MUCABELA program

The health care workers will have to carry out the program in mission mode: CM

Keeping those who have been deprived of social pension in mind, the state cabinet has decided to launch a new scheme called 'Mukhyamantri Samajik Sahayata Prakalp', informed Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha after

inaugurating State-level 'Mukhyamantri Cancer Asankramak Byedhi Sanaktokoron O Loksachetanata Abhigyaan' program organized by National Health Mission at Rabindra Bhawan today. He had also informed about few more cabinet decisions in the programme. Those include – recruitment of 6,067 persons for Special Executive post under the Home department, recruitment of 3,108 TET qualified individuals for teacher post and 15% salary increment of Anganwadi workers, helpers and ASHA workers of the state.

The Chief Minister said, there are still many poor people in the state who have not yet been brought under social pension scheme where in financial assistance of 2 thousand rupees would be provided. Keeping them in mind, the state government has decided to launch a new scheme called 'Mukhyamantri Samajik Sahayata Prakalp'. 30 thousand new beneficiaries have been brought under the scheme. They will be receiving monthly social pension of 2 thousand rupees.

The Chief Minister said, about 30% of cancer patients are affected with mouth cancer. That is why it is important to increase awareness on this matter. For this, the health department must take the initiative to conduct more awareness

programs. He called upon the doctors and the health care workers to carry out the 'Mukhyamantri Cancer Asankramak Byedhi Sanaktokoron O Loksachetanata Abhigyaan' in mission mode and result in cent percent success. The Chief Minister said, the state government has recently taken up 'Prati Ghare Sushason' campaign in order to deliver benefits of different schemes of the central and state government to every citizen. As a part of the campaign, different Melas and camps will be organized. He directed the health department to take initiative to conduct awareness campaign on MUCABELA.

Principal Secretary of Health department J. K. Sinha said, the doctors and the health care workers are tirelessly working to keep the human civilization alive. They have given day and night service even during Covid-19 situation. Everyone has to work in mission mode to make this campaign successful.

NHM Director Subhashish Das in his welcome speech said, under MUCABELA, diagnosing symptoms on primary phase will be given importance through diagnosis of mouth, breast and uterus cancer besides screening of different non-communicable diseases. The campaign will be held across the state from October 15, 2022 till February 14, 2023.

President of Indian Dental Association, State Division, Dr. Partha Roy Chowdhury and Director of Health Services Dr. Subhashish Debbarma spoke in the programme. West Tripura district, South Tripura district, Sepahijala district and Dhalai districts have been awarded for successful implementation of the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act, 2003 or COTPA, 2003, tobacco free educational institution, tobacco free campaign etc.. District NSD Cell of four districts (South Tripura, West Tripura, Unakoti and Sepahijala district) of National Program for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke program were awarded for providing tireless services. Four dental doctors (Medical Officer) of the state were also awarded in the programme for providing treatment services and for the successful implementation of National Oral Health Program.

State government is implementing development works under the guidance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He said, paragliding started in Jampui hill on September 29. It is a unique component of adventure tourism. This paragliding centre will attract tourists of the state and even outside states.

Social welfare and Social Education Minister Santana Chakma also hoped that launching of the paragliding facility at Jampui Hill will attract the tourists. TIDC Chairman Tinku Roy, DM of North Tripura DM Nagesh Kumar B, DSP Kiran Kumar and other officials were present in the programme. The programme was presided over by the Chairman of Jampui Hill Block Advisory Committee.

Prati Ghare Sushason camp at Chinibagan Bazar of Gournagar block

A block-level Prati Ghare Sushason camp was held at Chinibagan Bazar shed of

Gournagar block yesterday. Those present at the camp were Chairman of Gournagar Panchayat Samiti Naran Sinha, ADM of Unakoti district Francis Darlong, Kailasahar SDM Pradip Sarkar, Gournagar block BDO Rameswar Chakraborty and officials of different departments. Construction of new Pucca houses for 141 beneficiary families of Gournagar block has been approved under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin in the camp. Apart from that, construction of lavatories for 36 beneficiary families of the block has been approved under Swachha Bharat Mission and job cards have been provided to 32 beneficiary families of the block under MGNREGA. 34 persons of the block have been registered under ROR and new ration cards have been provided to two persons in the camp.

Two farmers have been registered under PMKISAN. Loans of 14 lakh rupees have been provided to 10 Self-Help Groups of the block in the block-level camp. 81 PRTC, 93 ST, a Marriage certificate have been provided on behalf of the Sub-Division Administration and applications for Aadhar card (35) and income certificates (30) have been received in the camp.
