Award of excellence was announced for taking apt steps to maintain communication during Covid-19 situation

Agartala Smart City Ltd was handed Award of Excellence for taking apt steps to maintain communication during Covid-19 from the Union Ministry of Home and Urban Development yesterday through video conferencing organised in the auditorium hall at Nagar Unnayan Bhawan. Sailesh Kumar Yadav, Chief Executive Officer, Agartala Smart City Ltd while speaking to media said, 'For controlling traffic through intelligent traffic management system across the city and monitoring traffic rule breakers through CCTV, taking steps for timely clearing water-clogging in drains when rain water flooded the city, for taking apt steps regarding motor vehicles in the city etc, Agartala Smart City Ltd was awarded with Excellence Award.'

In the press conference he said that traffic has become manageable after installing monitors for red light rule breakers in 22 big street junctions and for automatic registering of the number plates of the traffic rule breakers. Mr. Yadav also said that 450 CCTVs have been installed for monitoring flood conditions in the city. Through this the authority will be able to take prompt action to monitor pump and sluice gates for timely draining out flood water during flood. Due to this flood problems have reduced to great extent in comparison to yesteryears. He said that awareness is being spread to ensure social distancing and pollution free environment by using more battery vehicles and bicycles for which making of bicycle tracks in the city has started. He expressed that various problems in the city were solved by Agartala Smart City during the Covid-19 situation.
