The representative of science, technology and environment department informed that 5 KW power plant had been installed in Toidu and Chhabimura. 10 KW power plant had been installed at Tepania Eco park and 65 street lights have been installed in Matabari.

Preparation meeting on independence day at Jompuijala

72nd Independence Day will be observed through various programmes in Jompuijala subdivision. In this connection a preparatory meeting was held at Jompuijala SDM office recently. SDPO Bikash Debbarma, BDO Barun Debbarma, officers

Health camp schedule in Killa

Distribution of LED bulbs in Nagbongshi Market
