



lane expressway from Agartala airport to Amtali so as to facilitate same day trip to Matabari Temple in Udaipur. On this the Central Minister assured top priority and requested the State Government to complete land acquisition for the same. Apart from this, matters like road safety measures, strengthening of regional office of NHIDCL (in charge of road safety task) in Tripura, flood control etc. came up for discussion.

On the request of the Chief Minister the Union Health Minister agreed to set expenditure ratio at 90:10 between Centre and State for implementation of Ayushman-Bharat. He also informed that assistance upto Rs. 200 crore could be provided for setting up Super Specialty Block in GB Hospital attached to the medical college and the proposal for setting up AIIMS in Tripura has been recommended to the Ministry of Finance. The Ministry of Health would pursue the matter with the concerned ministry.

Considering the profit-making status of OTPC, which is running the power project at Palatana the Chief Minister proposed to review the agreement with OTPC under which it is enjoying waiver from VAT, the Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas (P&NG) stated that since there was a formal agreement on this issue, it would be appropriate to have the matter examined by a committee consisting of members from the stakeholders including P&NG first and

this committee would suggest a course of action. Other issues discussed were – increasing production of gas in the state, setting up of more CNG filling stations, etc.

Administrative camp to be held on 7 July at Dayalpara Village

Sonamura subdivisional administration in association with Boxanagar Block and Boxanagar Panchayat Samiti will be organising an administrative-cum-health camp at Jharajala SB School under Dayalpara ADC Village on July 7. In that camp health check-up and necessary medicines will be provided free of cost to the patients from the health department and necessary medicines will also be provided by the ARD department for livestocks. Certificate for ST, marriage registration, PRTC and income would be issued in the camp on the basis of current application. In presence of SDM in the camp an interactive meeting on development activities will be held. Public representatives and officials from various line departments would be present in that camp.

23,966 Person-days work through MGNREGA in Kadamtala Block

In the previous three months 23,966 person-days have been generated through various developmental works under MGNREGA in 19 Gram Panchayat areas under Kadamtala Block. In this process 3,925 persons from 3,545 families got

employment. For this purpose an amount of Rs. 42 Lakh 41 thousand 982 has been spent. On the other hand, in the current financial year till date work of 10,241 person-days have been generated through MGNREGA in 19 Gram Panchayats and 3 ADC Villages area under Jubarajnagar Block of Dharmanagar subdivision. In this programme 1,616 persons from 1,501 families got work. An amount of Rs. 18 Lakh 12 thousand 657 has been spent for this purpose. This information has been disseminated by the North Tripura District administration.

General meeting of Santirbazar Municipal Council held

A general meeting of Santirbazar Municipal Council was held on July 4 in the conference hall of SDM office of Santirbazar. In presence of MLA Pramode Reang and representatives from different offices the administrator of Santirbazar Municipal Council cum Subdivisional Magistrate Animesh Debbarma presided over the meeting. TUEP and other development activities were taken up in that meeting. While speaking in that meeting MLA Pramode Reang stressed on having proper drainage system in municipal area. The SDM made an appeal to all the officials to step forward in the work of disaster management.

Chicks to be distributed among 1200 beneficiaries of Dhalai

The District office of ARD department has taken initiative to distribute 1200 units of chicks and poultry feed among 1200 beneficiaries of Ambassa, Salema, Durga Chowmuhani, Ganganagar, Manu, Chawmanu, Dumburnagar and Raishyabari under Dhalai District. For this activity an amount of Rs. 3,750 would be spent for per unit of chick and poultry feed. Out of these, 300 units of chicks and poultry feed have been distributed among 300 beneficiaries of Ambassa and Salema Block. Apart from this, for 9 beneficiaries of Balaram ADC village under Ambassa Block 9 unit of pigs, Pig-feed and rearing house for pig would be constructed through central sponsored scheme. For this Rs.11 thousand would be spent for per unit.

Health camp in Tirthamukh and Natunbazar

Health camps were organized by Tirthamukh P.H.C recently in 4 places of Tirthamukh. A total of 302 patients were treated and provided required medicine in the health camps of Dinchandra para, Sindhujoy para, Karaichhara and Mandirghat. Moreover, four health camps were organized by Natunbazar Rural hospital recently in several places. 99 patients were treated and provided required medicine in these health camps. The health camps were held in Laipad para, Sukai das para, Aayarai para and Bholanath para S.B school.
