Power tillers on subsidized rate provided in Ampinagar block

Betel nut plantation has been raised by the agriculture and farmers welfare department for 58 beneficiaries of 9 ADC villages of Ampinagar block under MGNREGA during the last financial year. 15,254 mandays had been generated under the scheme at the cost of Rs 39 lakh 24 thousand 338. 24

persons of Ampinagar and Gamaichhara village of Ampinagar block, 8 persons of Ekjanchhara, 12 persons of Tuichakma and South Ampinagar village, 12 of Chhechuria, Baishayamoni and Dhanlekha and 2 persons of Toidudhepa have benefited under the scheme. On the other hand, 85 farmers have been provided power tillers with each at subsidized rate of Rs 75000 under SMAM Scheme of the agriculture and farmers welfare department during the last financial year to facilitate cultivation in 22 ADC Villages of the block. Agriculture superintendent of Ampinagar sub-division Kahinoor Debbarma informed this.

215 Domestic water supply connection in Khowai Municipal area

Till now domestic drinking water supply connection under Atal Jaldhara Mission has been provided to 215 houses among the inhabitants of Khowai Municipal area. 150 more domestic connections will also be provided. Vice- chairman of Khowai Municipal Council Debasish Nath Sharma informed that work of installation of 700 metre long new pipeline from Khowai sub divisional DWS office area to Revenue Dak bungalow is nearing completion. Rs 35 lakh will be spent for this work. Vice- chairman informed that a plan has been taken to install 5 deep tube wells including ground water treatment plants in various areas for providing domestic water connection to each house of 15 wards in the municipal area.
