

Toilets provided to 16,169 families under Swachch Bharat Kosh

16,169 families of eight blocks of North Tripura district under Swachch Bharat Kosh had been implemented as per base line survey of 2012. Under the scheme Rs 12 thousand has been spent for construction of each toilet. Total 19 core 40 lakh 28 thousand had been spent for implementation of the scheme, member secretary of Swachch Bharat Nirman North Tripura District management committee Bidhan Das informed this. He informed that 4,976 toilets were constructed in Kadamtala block, 4,251 toilets in Kalachhara block, 1,192 toilets in Jubarajnagar block, 685 toilets in Panisagar block, 406 toilets in Jampuihill block, 1,185 toilets in Laljuri block, 490 toilets in Dasda block and 2,984 toilets in Damchhera block.

competition for below 14,17 and 19 years boys and girls will be held at Tripura Sports School on August 3 and 4. Swimming competition for below 14, 17 and 19 years boys and girls will be held at Udaipur on August 10. Gymnastics competition for below 14, 17 and 19 year boys and girls will be held at Agartala on August 10. Kho-Kho competition for under 17 year boys and girls will be held at Bishalgarh on August 22 and 23.

Kabbadi competition for under 17 and 21 boys and girls will be held at Kumarghat on August 22 and 23. Volley ball competition for below 17 year boys and girls will be held in Khowai district on September 6 and 7. Handball competition for below 17 boys and girls will be held at Kamalpur on September 6 and 7. Table tennis competition for below 14 and 17 boys and girls will be held at Belonia on September 13. Below 14 and 17 Badminton competition for boys and girls will be held at Panisagar on September 13. Below 14 boys Football Competition will be held at Kailashahar on September 23 and 24. Athletics competition for below 14, 17 and 19 year boys and girls will be held in West district on September 23. Below 17 boys and girls basket ball competition will be held at Udaipur on October 21 and 22. Below 17 year boys hokey competition will be held at Sonamura on October 21 and

22. Tug-of-war competition for boys and girls will take place at Dharmanagar on October 25. Handball competition for below 14 year girls will be held at Ambassa on October 25. Every event will be held from block to state level.
