

Distribution of text books starts in Khowai & Dhalai district

In the very beginning of the new academic year distribution of text books has started in Khowai district even during the lockdown. Text books are being given to the students of one to eight standard. Distribution of text books is going on in 90 schools of Khowai school inspectorate, 63 schools of Teliamura school inspectorate, 21 schools of Mungiakami school inspectorate, 46 schools of Kalyanpur school inspectorate, 40 schools of Padmabil school inspectorate and 40 schools of Tulashikhar school inspectorate. Besides, text books have reached 35 schools of Mungiakami school inspectorate, 45 schools of Tulashikhar school inspectorate and 60 schools of Hareshkumar school inspectorate under ADC administration. Distribution in these schools will be completed in few days.

In addition, under Khowai subdivision Rs. 28,03,035 for the students of 271 schools and Rs. 26,15,550 for the students of 192 schools under Teliamura subdivision is being distributed through bank accounts as Mid-day-meal allowance. This information has been given by the Khowai district education officer Samarendra Das.

On the other hand, distribution of text books has started in the schools of Dhalai district also. The process has started in 28 schools (out of total 59) of Ambassa school inspectorate, 16 schools (out of total 31) of Chhailengta school inspectorate, 70 schools (out of total 120) of Khumthua school inspectorate (under ADC), 40 schools (out of total 128) of Raishyabari school inspectorate (ADC), 13 schools (out of total 17) of Gandachera school inspectorate, 75 schools (out of total 150) of Kamalpur school inspectorate. Distribution will start in the remaining schools very shortly. In every case Corona related norms are being maintained. Besides, books have reached 109 schools of Chhamanu school inspectorate (ADC). This information has been given by the district education officer Arjun Sharma.

15,76,749 MGNREGA mandays generated in Dharamanagar subdivision

During the current financial year a total of 15,76,749 mandays have been created under MGNREGA in Kadamtala, Kalachera and Jubarajnagar block of Dharamanagar subdivision. An amount of Rs. 30,27,35,808 has been spent for this purpose. Under the scheme, renovation of rural roads, earth leveling, plantation etc. activities were

done. Under the scheme, in Kadamtala block 5,15,977 mandays have been generated at the cost of Rs. 9,90,67,584; in Kalachera block 5,26,624 mandays have been generated at the cost of Rs. 10,11,11,808 and in Jubarajnagar block 5,34,148 mandays have been generated at the cost of Rs. 10,25,56,415. Assistance to storm affected 273 families of Khowai

Homestead of 273 families in several areas of Khowai district have been affected by storm recently. Among them, 218 families in different areas of Teliamura subdivision and 55 families are from Khowai subdivision. Deputy Collector of Khowai district administration Shankar Narayan Das informed that administration provided Rs 39, 10,400 to 273 affected families. District administration also informed that crop in 312.5 hectare land of 2864 farming families has been affected by storm in different agri-subdivisions of the district.

Assistance provided to pregnant and lactating mothers

939 pregnant women and 1024 lactating mothers totaling 1963 names have been registered with 305 Anganwadi centres of

Panisagar block, Jubarajnagar block and Panisagar NP under Panisagar ICDS project area in North Tripura district. Anganwadi workers are delivering rice, dal and egg to the houses of 883 pregnant women and 976 lactating mothers totaling 1859 persons. 421 pregnant women and 469 lactating mothers totaling 890 registered with 146 Anganwadi centres of different gaon panchayats of Jubarajnagar block have benefited through the scheme. 64 pregnant women and 79 lactating mothers totaling 143 persons have benefited through registration of their names with Anganwadi centres of ADC village in Jubarajnagar block.

Similarly, 297 pregnant women and 307 lactating mothers totaling 604 persons have registered their names with 99 Anganwadi centres of different gaon panchayats in Panisagar block. 59 pregnant women and 73 lactating mothers totaling 132 persons registered with 22 Anganwadi centres of different ADC villages of Panisagar block have also benefited. Moreover, 42 pregnant women and 48 lactating mothers totaling 90 persons registered with 15 Anganwadi centres of Panisagar NP area have benefited. The office of North district social welfare and social education department has informed this.
