### Govt. Introduces new award 'Sardar Patel National Unity Award'

The Government of India has introduced a new award called 'Sardar Patel National Unity Award' to be conferred on personalities who have contributed immensely to the unity and integrity of the country. Announcing this in a gazette notification the Ministry of Home Affairs has informed that this award will be a type of medal made of gold and silver. On one side will be symbolic petal of lotus and on the other side will be photo of Sardar Patel inscribed. It will be handed over to the recipient by the President of India. A person receiving this honour may wear it on his / her chest on certain occasions. However, the President may withdraw the award and reinstate the same if he/she feels it necessary by publishing it in official gazette.

# Conclave for bamboo artisans: Govt. to support bamboo-based enterprises

The chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb has invited the local and outside investors to come forward for promotion of bamboo sector and bamboo based industries in the state. On this, the chief minister assured that the state government would provide all-out support. Inaugurating the Bamboo Artisans Conclave organised by Tripura Bamboo Mission at Rabindra Shatabarshiki Bhavan yesterday the chief minister said, bamboo, rubber, gas and different fruits are grown in abundance in the state. Utilising these resources investors have to come ahead to establish big industries.



At present Tripura has 17,000 hectare land available for bamboo cultivation. Tripura Small Industries Corporation Limited is responsible for supplying these bamboos to the industrialists. For this purpose necessary fund will be given by Tripura Bamboo Mission. The chief minister also said, recently the Prime Minister has reduced the corporate tax. Benefit of this initiative has to be reaped by the entrepreneurs. Tripura Industrial Development Corporation has also taken several measures for the development of small industries in the state.

#### Cash crop cultivation in Lefunga & Hejamara blocks

Different cash crops have been cultivated by West Tripura district horticulture and soil conservation office in 12 hectare land of Lefunga block and 13 hectare land of Hejamara block. Rs 35 lakh 85 thousand will be spent for implementation of the scheme under SCA and TSS projects. Among these, Rs 17 lakh 20 thousand will be spent for cultivation of cash crop in 12 hectare land of Lefunga block. 24 families will be benefited under the scheme. On the other hand, Rs 18 lakh 64 thousand 200 will be spent for cultivation of cash crop in 13 hectare land of Hejamara block. 26 families will be benefited under the scheme.

#### Renovation of betel leaf garden in West district

Betel leaf garden is being renovated by West Tripura district horticulture and soil conservation office as a part of assistance provided to the farmers for betel leaf cultivation in West Tripura district. Rs 4 lakh will be spent for the scheme under DDH project of state plan. As per the scheme, renovation of betel nut garden is going on in 15 hectare land of Jirania block, 10 hectare land of Dukli block, 10 hectare land of Bamutia block and 5 hectare land of Hejamara block. West Tripura district horticulture and soil conservation office has informed this.

#### Administrative camp held in Nabinchhara village

An administrative cum health camp was organized by Kumarghat Sub divisional administration at market shed of Nabinchhara village of Pacherthal block on September 27. D.M of Unakoti district Rabindra Reang alongwith other officers of various departments visited houses constructed under PM Awas Yojana, Anganwadi centre, bamboo plantation, health centre, Tushitpuri Bana Vihar area etc of the village. Income certificates have been provided to 25 persons on urgent application basis. Health department provided required medicine after treatment of 22 persons. Animal resources development department provided various preventive medicines to the animal rearers.
