Sports Minister greets the winners of Self-defence competition

13 players of Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Self Defence Combat Association of Jogendranagar held runners up position in combat competition held at Simulguri of Assam in December. Assam state holds first position in the competition. Total 8 states such as Delhi, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Assam, Nagaland, Manipur, West Bengal and Tripura participated in the competition. The competition was held from 28th to 30th December, 2018. In the competition Tripura achieved 7 golds, 3 silvers, 1 bronze and one trophy.

The 13 players met the Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports at the secretariat on 2nd January. Coach of the team Debika Acharjee handed over the trophy and awards to the Sports Minister. Sports Minister appreciated them. He said that assistance will be provided to them as per rules of State Sports Council. He also mentioned that Tripura became champion in U-17 women football tournament held in the month of December.

It is decided in the meeting that district level Jatra Utsav will be organized by ICA department in the second half of January, 2019. 9 jatra teams of 3 subdivisions of the district will participate in the festival. In the meeting, Jatra Utsav committee appealed to the concerned Jatra teams to submit filled-in forms to Sepahijala DICA office for participation by 7th January.

Development of infrastructure in different schools of Sepahijala district

Infrastructure of different schools is being upgraded in Sepahijala district. Construction of two storied building of Rabindranagar H.S School of Kathalia

block under Samagra Shiksha Abhijan has been completed at the cost of Rs 2 crore. Construction of the building of South Nirvoypur H.S School of Kathalia block under the minority welfare scheme has been completed at the cost of Rs 2 crore.

Construction of the building of Shantinagar H.S School of Sepahijala district has been completed at the cost of Rs 2 crore. The buildings of Nagar H.S School of Boxanagar block and South Paharpur H.S School of Mohanbhog block under the scheme have been completed at the cost of Rs 2 crore each. Moreover, construction of the two storied building of Boxanagar H.S School at the cost of Rs 7.77 crore and the building of Durgapur H.S School at the cost of RS 32 crore is going on.

Health camps in three places of Shilachhari

Health camps were organized by Shilachhari P.H.C in three places in the month of December. 13 patients in the health camp at Tulamura Budhamandir Ailmara, 203 patients in the health camp at Shilachhari P.H.C and 11 patients in the health camp at Kasturba High School of

Hajachhari have been provided medical treatment. Required medicines were also provided to the patients in the health camps.

Bamboo plantation in West district under Integrated Watershed Scheme

Initiative has been taken for raising bamboo plantation over 8.04 ha. area in different blocks of West Tripura district under Integrated Watershed Scheme. Already bamboo plantation has been done over 6.04 ha. area. In implementation of this scheme an amount of Rs. 9,25,104 will be spent.

Giving further details the officer-in-charge of the West Tripura district Integrated Watershed Project said, already planting bamboo saplings of Betu variety in 3 ha. of Hezamara block, Rupai and Mrittinga variety in 3.04 ha. of Jirania block has been completed. On the other hand, planting of sapling is going on in 1 ha. land out of proposed 2 ha. in Mandai block. Under the programme Rs. 5,75,731 has been spent. In addition, bamboo plantation over 8.96 ha. in Hezamara block has been reclaimed.
