Assistance for animal husbandry in Dhalai district

With the objective of making tribal people financially self-sufficient through animal husbandry assistance will be provided to 72 poor tribal families of 8 blocks of Dhalai district by animal resources development department for pig farming

with the fund from tribal welfare department. Under the scheme 6 poor families from Manu, Domburnagar, Chhamanu. Raishyabari, Ganganagar blocks and 3 poor families from Ambassa, Salema and Durga Chownuhani blocks will be benefited. 3 Pigs, medicine, utensil and feed will be provided to each beneficiary family. Assistance will be provided to total 33 families including 6 families each of Salema. Domburnagar and Ambassa blocks and 3 families each of Manu, Durga chowmuhani, Chhamanu, Raishyabari and Ganganagar blocks for goat farming. 4 lambs will be provided to each beneficiary-family.
