

Govt. coming up with new scheme for UPSC aspirants

As a token of encouragement to the UPSC aspirants the state government has come up with a new scheme called 'Lakshya'. It is a scholarship scheme to cater to the UPSC aspirants of the state who clear the preliminary examination. The candidates may avail of the benefits of the scheme in two stages, either after clearing the preliminary examination or after clearing the main examination and before appearing for the interview. This is a special scholarship scheme from the chief minister.

The scheme has been designed to enable the UPSC aspirants with better coaching facility. Once the preliminary is cleared they can avail Rs. 70000 for coaching and Rs. 30,000 on account of transportation. Again another Rs. 20,000 will be given for the main examination. If the main examination is cleared candidates selected for interview will be given free accommodation in Tripura Bhava, New Delhi. The higher education department of the Government of Tripura will be in charge of implementing this scheme.

Eligibility for availing this facility will be – candidate will be a permanent resident of Tripura whose annual family income could not exceed Rs. 10 lakh. Within two months from the declaration of preliminary results the eligible candidates have apply online to the director of higher education and submit documents as required. The concerned department will have to make arrangements for feedback from the candidates. This information has been given by the higher education department through a press release.
