

DDU-GKY centre opened with new trades

A new centre of Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gramin Kaushal Vikash Yojana was opened at Hapania today. Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission under the rural development ministry has launched this centre. This centre will be managed by Orion Security Solutions Private Limited. MLA Ramprasad Paul was present there as the chief guest. Under the scheme skill development training will be provided to 28,000 unemployed youths, as per target, informed the chief executive officer TRLM Sudhakar Sindhe. At a time 245 youths could be trained in this centre. Trades in which training will be imparted are – security supervisor, CCTV supervisor, un-armed security guard, housekeeping executive, housekeeping attendant etc. Duration of each course will be three months and in addition there will be a one-month internship.

Demo train flagged off – greater commuter convenience

Eyeing commuter convenience another rail service saw the light of the day on October 3. The chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb flagged off the demo-rail service between Agartala-Sabroom and

Agartala-Dharmanagar at Agartala rail station, in presence of MP Pratima Bhowmik, state transport minister Pranajit Singha Roy and other dignitaries.



Speaking on the occasion the chief minister thanked the Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union railway minister and state transport department for being able to start the service before Durga Puja as it was a commitment of the state government. He said, express trains are not being able to run everyday due to the single track issue. Towards solving this issue survey for construction of 41.75 km. rail line between Dharmanagar-Kailashahar-Pecharthal is going on. On completion of the survey construction is expected to start from December this year. With this Kailashahar will be brought under the rail network and for this an amount of Rs. 1713 crore will be spent. On the other hand, construction of an alternative rail line from Dharmanagar to

Belonia via Pecharthal-Khowai-Agartala will start once survey work gets completed by 2020. This project will be worth Rs. 6000-7000 crore investment.

Terming the day as historic MP Pratima Bhowmik said, she has requested the central government for reserving 100 seats under VIP quota in all the express trains plying to and fro Tripura. Transport minister Pranajit Singha Roy said, due to introduction of six express trains communication system of the state has improved remarkably. NF Railway general manager Sanjib Roy delivered welcome address. Among other dignitaries were present MLA Ratan Chakraborty, MLA Ramprasad Paul, MLA Mimi Majumder, MLA Sudhan Das, MLA Prabhat Chowdhury, chief secretary U. Venkateswaralu and secretary of transport department L.H. Darlong.
