

this. Construction of rest four roads is going on through which 7016 mandays are being generated and 9 lakh 38 thousand 518 is being spent for this.

On the other hand, construction of houses for 240 families of the village under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana had been started. Already construction of houses for 232 poor tribal families has been completed. Under Swachh **Bharat** Mission, scientific toilets have been constructed for 230 families of the village. Rs 12 thousand has been spent in of construction each toilet. information has been given by the Village Committee office.

Initiative for re-furbishing of Kamalasagar

A meeting was held at the conference hall of Bishalgarh SDM office to provide various facilities to tourists visiting Kamalasagar and re-embellish it. SDM of Bishalgarh subdivision Sudhakar V Sindhe and officers of TSECL, DWS, ICA and RD departments were present in the meeting. Various plans have been taken in the meeting chaired by the SDM. A plan has been taken to construct brick soling road and car parking with boundary wall in Kamalasagar tourist spot at the cost of Rs 25 lakh, construct 6 new market stalls beside the temple at the cost of Rs 17

lakh, construct 1 open rest room at the cost of Rs 10 lakh, renovate old market stalls spending Rs 7 lakh.

Among other decisions were decoration of the park adjacent to the temple at the cost of Rs 10 lakh, construction of dustbin at the cost of Rs 3 lakh, decoration of various boundary wall of the tourist spot at the cost of Rs 4 lakh, construction of a concrete drain at the cost of Rs 7 lakh, decoration of the craft centre anew at the cost of Rs 8 lakh, construction of a road from the Annabhog for temple counter convenience of the pilgrims and introduction of two new boats for boating in Kamalasagar lake at the cost of Rs 5 lakh. Moreover, a plan has been taken for construction of a museum for disseminating information to tourists. An amount of Rs 1 crore 12 lakh 60 thousand will be spent for implementation of these schemes. ONGC Tripura Asset will assist financially in the schemes.

Assistance for pisci-culture in Kanchanpur

Assistance has been given by the fisheries department during the current financial year to 3 patta-holding beneficiaries for psci culture in total 0.52 hectare waterbodies under forest area of various ADC villages in Dasda block.
