High yielding *aman* paddy cultivation under SRI system in Padmabil

High yielding *aman* paddy has been cultivated in 775 hectare land under SRI system in Padmabil agri-subdivision area during the current financial year. Rs 3,918 per hectare land totaling Rs 30 lakh 36 thousand 450 has been spent for this purpose. Moreover, high yielding *aman*

paddy has been cultivated in 320 hectare land. Rs 7,500 per hectare land totaling Rs 24 lakh has been spent for this purpose. Agriculture superintendent of Padmabil agriculture subdivisional office Arabinda Debbarma has informed this.

Rs 8 core 98 lakh collected in Dhalai district

Rs 8 core 98 lakh has been collected in Dhalai district under small saving scheme up to the month of July of the current financial year. Out of this, Rs 4 core 88 lakh has been collected in Kamalpur subdivision, Rs 2 core 62 lakh in Ambassa subdivision, Rs 1 core 34 lakh in Longtharai valley subdivision, and Rs 14 lakh in Gandachhara subdivision has been collected. A target has been set for collection of Rs 22 core under small saving scheme in Dhalai district during the current financial year. Of the total amount, collection of Rs 12 core 20 lakh target has been set for Kamalpur subdivision, Rs 4 core 30 lakh for Ambassa subdivision, Rs 5 core for Longtharai valley subdivision and Rs 50 lakh for Gandachhara subdivision.
