



400 KV sub-station at Surjyamaninagar

A review meeting was held in connection with construction of 400 KV power sub-station at East Naogaon of Dukli block and conversion of 132 KV sub-station at Surjyamaninagar into 400 KV sub-station at the state secretariat yesterday. The Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb, in presence of the Deputy Chief Minister Jishnu Dev Varma, chief secretary L.K. Gupta, additional chief secretary Sushil Kumar, CMD of TSECL Dr. Murhari Sapanrao Kele, presided over the meeting.

Principal secretary Manoj Kumar stated that in order to strengthen the power network initiative was taken to set up 400 KV power sub-station at East Naogaon through a private agency namely Star Light Company. Once this work is completed sub-station at Surjyamaninagar and sub-station at Comilla of Bangladesh will get power from this project. Moreover, plan is there to convert the 132 KV sub-station at Surjyamaninagar to a 400 KV sub-station so that Tripura State Electricity Corporation Limited could directly transmit power to Bangladesh after collecting from OTPC plant.

Addressing the meeting the Chief Minister hoped that this new arrangement would speed up the process of development in

the state. He said, now a conducive environment for setting up wood, steel, rubber, bamboo-based industries has been developed. In that case electricity generated in our state could be utilized in our own benefit, thus augmenting the employment opportunities.

42,242 Toilets constructed in North district under Swachh Bharat Mission

Construction of 42, 242 toilets has been completed in eight blocks of North Tripura district under Swachh Bharat Mission (rural). The beneficiaries were from both categories – APL and BPL. Construction of more 2,532 toilets is under progress. Under this scheme target for construction of toilets was set at 15,398 APL families of which 14, 440 toilets have been completed so far. Work for rest of the toilets (958) is going on. Target in BPL category was 13, 038 families out of which toilets for 11, 766 families have been completed so far, and work for 1,272 toilets is under progress. In addition, renovation of toilets for 16,338 families was taken up. Out of this, renovation of 16, 036 toilets has already been completed. Renovation for rest 302 toilets is going on. Construction of each toilet will incur an expenditure of Rs. 12,000.

Gas connection provided under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana in Dharmanagar

A target has been taken to provide gas connection to 20,333 beneficiaries free of cost under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana in Dharmanagar subdivision. Out of this, 8,512 persons have already been provided gas connection. SDM of Dharmanagar subdivision informed that a target has been taken to provide gas connection to 10,333 persons through Joyram Gas Agency of Dharmanagar under this scheme. Out of this, 4,538 persons have already been provided gas connection. A target has been taken to provide gas connection to 10,000 persons through Tripureshwari Gas Agency. Out of this, 3,974 persons have already been provided gas connection.
