

Relief distribution by Amarpur Red Cross Society

1,322 Persons benefit under social security pension schemes in Jampuihill Block

Relief materials distributed in Jirania

Relief materials were distributed among 300 poor families of Jiranira block on May 3. Organised at Binapani School ground the deputy chief minister Jishnu Dev Varma handed over food items to the beneficiaries. The programme was also attended by MLA Sushanta Chowdhury, chairman of Jirania Panchayat Samiti Manju Das, vice-chairman Pritam Debnath and social activist Gouranga Bhowmik. Speaking on the occasion the deputy chief

minister said, in view of the economic impact of COVID-19 situation decision has been taken to create employment through MGNREGA activities in rural areas and advised to maintain social distance while working. Later on the deputy chief minister had a review meeting with the officials of Jirnia power division. He advised to complete the pending works of renovation and other service related works.

22,889 Beneficiaries getting social pensions in Sepahijala district

In Sepahijala district social security pension is being given to 22,889 persons under central and state schemes. Out of the total number of beneficiaries, 14,681 persons are getting central scheme pensions and 8,208 persons are getting state government's pensions. During the lockdown period the pension for April and May has been given in advance. Giving further details the district officer of social welfare and social education department Dr. Chandrani Biswas said, under Bishalgarh ICDS project 6,873 persons, under Boxanagar ICDS project 3,058 persons and under Jampuijala ICDS project 3,533 persons, under Kanthalia ICDS project 3,021 persons, under Melaghar ICDS project 6,085 and under Sonamura Nagar Panchayat ICDS project 319 persons are getting social pensions.
