Under the aegis of Dhalai District health and family welfare society a review meeting of the district level health related governing body was held at the DM's office conference hall yesterday. DM of Dhalai district Vikash Singh, member-secretary of Dhalai district Swachh Bharat Mission Hiranmoy Chakma along with medical officers and health staff were present in the meeting. DM of Dhalai district Vikash Singh, CMO of Dhalai Dr. Saradindu Reang, Consultant of World Health Organisation Dr. Mahesh Patil, Officer of Social welfare and Social education department Jyotirmoy Debnath discussed on vaccination of children, vaccination of pregnant mother, nutritional food, institutional delivery, organizing health camps for prevention of malaria and awareness generation, giving more stress on organizing health and nutrition day in the villages, *Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram*, Mission Indradhanush, Measles and Rubella vaccination, works of Patients' Welfare

Society, arrangement of drinking water in the PHCs and health outreach services in the distant villages.

CMO of Dhalai Dr. Saradindu Reang informed in the meeting that during the current year from September 15 to till date Measles and Rubella vaccine has been administered among 1 lakh 10 thousand 350 children under the age group of 9 months to 15 years of this district. Target was to administer vaccine among 1 lakh 14 thousand 176 children. Apart from that, distribution of 400 mosquito nets is going on to prevent malaria in various villages under 8 blocks of Dhalai district.

### **Administrative camp held in Charilam**

Under the aegis of Bishalgarh subdivisional administration an administrative camp was held in the Charilam market premises on December 5. In that administrative camp 179 marriage registration certificates, birth certificates to 10 persons and death certificate to 1 person were issued by the subdivisional administration.
