



July 6. SDM of Khowai subdivision Sonakshi Singh Tomar, BDO of Tulashikar block B. Darlong and officers of various departments were present in the camp. During the administrative camp SDM discussed on development schemes of various departments. SDM interacted with the local people regarding drinking water, health, education, communication and agriculture etc matters. Sub divisional administration provided 45 PRTC, 58 S.T certificates and 45 marriage certificates in the camp. Health department provided required medicine after treatment of 69 patients. Animal resources development department distributed various preventive medicines among the live stock farmers for treatment of 178 domestic animals and birds.

Mega health and blood donation camp at Bankumari

A mega health and blood donation camp was held at community hall of Bankumari in Pratapgarh on July 7. Speaker of Tripura Legislative Assembly Rebati Mohan Das inaugurated the camp organized by All Tripura Scheduled Caste Officers Welfare Society in association with All Tripura Government Doctors Association, Tripura Government Ayurvedic Association and Pratapgarh Mandal Committee. 350 patients have been treated and provided required medicine. Besides this, blood and eye test of the patients had been done. 60 patients participated in voluntary blood donation camp.

Integrated Pisci-culture in Killa block

Under Integrated Pisci-culture Scheme, assistance will be provided to 10 persons of Killa block belonging to tribal community for pisci culture during the current financial year. Under the scheme, 3200 fingerlings of different species, 50 Kg lime stone, 45 Kg oilcake, 140 floating fish feed and 160 Kg sinking fish feed will be provided to each beneficiary. Moreover, 3 pigs, 300 Kg feed for pigs and various preventive medicines will be provided to each beneficiary. Rs 41 thousand 500 will be spent for each beneficiary under the scheme. The office of Udaipur fishery supervisor's office informed this.

1,44,813 mandays generated in Damchera & Laljuri block

In all the ADC villages of Damchera and Laljuri block in North Tripura district 1,44,813 mandays have been generated under MGNREGA during the current financial year. These mandays were generated in works like renovation of roads, raising orchard, earth leveling etc. involving Rs. 2,78,04,096. The breakup of the same says that Damchera block had 72,433 mandays worth Rs. 1,39,07,136. Similarly, a total of 72,380 mandays were generated in Laljuri block involving an expenditure of Rs. 1,38,96,960. This information has been provided by the North Tripura DM office source.
