

## Parents-Teachers meeting held in all govt. & aided schools



As a part of different initiatives undertaken by the government Parents-Teacher meeting was organized by the school education department yesterday from 10 am. to 2 pm. in all 4349 government and government-aided schools of the state. On the day every school was decorated well and the parents of students were given a hearty welcome by the teachers. Invitee dignitaries and officers visited class rooms and encouraged the parents and teachers. Teachers also had face-to-face interaction with the parents. Discussion between the teachers and parents centered around students' learning level, first periodical test, attendance of their wards etc. Feedback from the parents was recorded in detail.

This massive step had seen 70.68 per cent participation of parents in the

programme. District-wise picture was like this – number of students' and parents' participation in West district was 58520 and 31311 respectively, in Sepahijala it was 46142 and 30334 respectively, in Khowai district it was 26046 and 17214 respectively, in North Tripura district it was 40129 and 32309 respectively, in Unakoti district it was 28693 and 22502 respectively, in Gomati district it was 37321 and 24838 respectively, whereas in South Tripura district it was 39539 and 33512 respectively and in Dhalai district it was 39880 and 31511 respectively. Every



year similar Parent-Teacher meeting will be organized three weeks before the half-yearly and annual examinations.

## Administrative tour & health camp in Ujan Pathalighat village

A daylong administrative-cum-health camp was organized by Sepahijala district administration in Ujan Pathalighat ADC village of Jampuijala district on September 6. Before starting the

programme, district and subdivision level officers under the leadership of D.M. C.K Jamatia visited different areas of Ujan Pathaliaghat and interacted with local people regarding various problems. The officers visited different roads, bridges, mulberry, pineapple and banana plantations, Anganwadi centre, school, irrigation system, drinking water sources etc. During the tour soap, toothbrush, nail-cutter, toothpaste etc. were distributed by the administration among old men and children as a cleanliness drive.

SDM of Jampuijala subdivision Sanjib Debbarma, BDO of Jampuijala block Barun Debbarma alongwith D.M were present in the administrative team. Local people interacted with the officers and discussed drinking water, irrigation system, MGNREGA, health care of mother and children, power, forestry, communication, rural development, food and rationing system, education, tribal welfare, Swaach Bharat Mission etc. issues of this area. On behalf of the administrative team assurance was given to solve the problems. In the meeting, the representatives of various departments informed the local people about of programmes of their respective department.

In the administrative cum health camp, 70 applications for issuing SC certificate and 72 applications for issuing PRTC have been received. Moreover, 12

income certificates have been issued on urgent basis. Animal resources development department provided required medicine to the animal rearers after checkup of the cattle. In the health camp, required medicines had been provided to 162 patients.

### **BADP in Durgachowmuhan block**

Various schemes under Border Areas Development Project are being implemented in Durga Chowmuhan block of Kamalpur subdivision. Construction of a water tank at Rakeshtila of Bilashchhara panchayat of the block is going on at the cost of Rs 5 lakh. Construction of a passenger-shed at Lambu chowmuhan of Lambuchhara ADC village is going on at the cost of Rs 5 lakh. A community toilet will be constructed at Erarpar of Manikbhandar panchayat at the cost of Rs 5 lakh. A box culvert will be constructed at Baraitali at the cost of Rs 20 lakh. A road will be constructed at Sanaiya Reang para of Shetrai ADC Village at the cost of Rs 7 lakh 3 thousand. Brick soling of the 3 K.M road from Kanailal Halam para of Dhanchandra ADC Village to Thangshi para via Paikar para at the cost of Rs 17.97 lakh is nearing completion. Construction of water tank at Thangshi para of Dhanchandra ADC village at the cost of Rs 5 lakh is going on.

### **Assistance provided for production of fingerling at Rupaichhari**

Assistance will be provided by Rupaichhari fishery superintendent's office to 5 families of Rupaichhari block under production of fingerling scheme. ### **Assistance provided for animal husbandry in Udaipur subdivision**

Assistance will be provided by animal resources development department to 24 tribal animal rearers of Udaipur subdivision with the tribal welfare fund for increasing income through animal husbandry. 6 persons each of Matabari, Kakraban-Tepania and Killa blocks will be benefited under the scheme. Assistance will be provided to two persons each of Matabari, Kakraban and Tepania blocks and three persons of Killa block for piggery farming. Assistance will be provided to three persons each of Matabari, Kakraban and Tepania blocks and two persons of Killa block under the scheme for goaterly farming. Assistance will be provided to one person each of Matabari, Kakraban, Tepania and Killa blocks for poultry farming.
