Dhalai district level workshop held on Measles Rubella vaccination

Keeping the objective of making the State Measles Rubella-free, a daylong district level workshop on Measles Rubella vaccination was held on July 9 at Ambassa Panchayati Raj Training Institute of Dhalai District. The workshop was organized in joint collaboration of World Health Organisation, health and family welfare department and Dhalai District Family Welfare Samiti. The district manager Subhadip Lodh of Chief Medical Officer's office of Dhalai District, the Consultant of World Health Organisation Dr. Mahesh Patil and the Chief Medical Officer of Dhalai Dr. Saradindu Reang discussed about what is Measles Rubella and also about the harmful effects of Measles Rubella.

In this workshop SDMO of Longtharai Valley subdivision, SDMO of Gandacherra subdivision, Medical Officer of Kamalpur subdivision, officer from Dhalai District Education Officer's Office, medical officers from health and family welfare department of this district and the officials from health department were present in the workshop. Vaccination would be administered on the age group of 9 months to 15 years boys and girls in schools, hospitals, CHCs, PHCs, Health

Sub-Centres, Anganwadi Centres and in other vaccination centers under this district.

Meeting held at Kalacharri on GDP Plan

A Meeting on Zone level Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) was held recently in Kalacharri Gram Panchayat office. The voluntary workers, farmers, students, house-wives across different sections of the society from Kalachari and Harerkhola Gram Panchayats under Durga Chowmuhani block of Kamalpur subdivision participated in that meeting. Addressing the participants the panchayat extension officer of the concerned block stated that development related affairs would be vested now in the hands of the of people that concerned gram panchayat. It is to be mentioned that proper planning of development works to be done for the village in upcoming five years would be there in the GPDP and concerned departments would execute development works in the village accordingly.

E-tendering for more transparency & integrity

Public Works Department (R&B) has introduced e-tendering system for more transparency and integrity. To get into the system minimum requirement is

laptop/ desktop computer with internet facility and Digitally Signed Certificate (DSC). Once DSC is procured, it requires registration through tender portal viz. www.tripuratenders.gov.in which is free of cost. In case the agency is not having their own laptops/ desktops, they can take support from Common Service Centres (CSCs) where such facilities are available. In absence of such CSCs, facilities of local private media centres/ cyber cafes can also be used. Since the data used in the application is totally encrypted, there is no chance of sharing tendering information like quoted rates, name of the bidders etc. with any one. Since it is totally "ON-LINE" based, so there is no room left to get the data saved in any system whether laptop or desktop, being used for the purpose. In this process neither the department nor the agencies involved in the bidding process, can see other activities and till the actual opening, no one can view the number of agencies participated in the bidding process.

In the meantime, a relaxation to the notification as issued by the CE, PWD (R&B) Dt. 23.05.2018 has been made, while tenders costing upto Rs. 5.0 lacs will remain either on-line or in conventional i.e. off line mode till September 01,2018. To further facilitate the agencies, guidelines with stage wise procedures to handle with software application has already been uploaded to the website of PWD viz. www.pwd.tripura.gov.in.
