'Angikar', 'Light House' – new gifts for Tripura

Targeting an improved urban life for the people a new programme called 'Angikar' was launched to coincide with the celebration of 150th birth anniversary of Launching Mahatma Gandhi. the programme 'Angikar', a state level publicity campaign about Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) at Agartala town hall on October 10 the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb informed, Tripura achieved first rank in the Northeast and second rank in the entire country in implementation of the said scheme.

The chief minister also said, 'Angikar' implemented would be mainly involving those who have benefited under PMAY (U). This three-month publicity campaign will focus on waste solar light, management, water conservation, tree plantation, use of LPG, Ayushman Bharat card, use of LED bulb under Ujala Yojana etc. He said, in addition to the ongoing project of constructing 1000 flats the government would also take initiate for constructing 1200 flats on the site where once central jail existed. He also informed, international shopping mall will constructed in the state. Tripura is one of

the six states selected by the central government for Light House project. Under this project also the government has decided to construct 1000 flats in Golchakkar area near Akhaura border.

On this occasion the special secretary of urban development department Kiran Gitte said, for the whole country 85 lakh houses have been sanctioned under PMAY. Out of this about 85,000 houses have been sanctioned for Tripura. Each beneficiary family will be given Rs. 1.66 lakh for construction of house. The programme was also attended by MLA Dr. Dilip Kumar Das, chairperson of Udaipur Municipal Council Shital Chandra Majumder, deputy mayor of Agartala Municipal Corporation Samar Chakraborty and other dignitaries.
