

## **State cabinet clears proposal for Rural Self-employment Training Institute at Bishramganj**

The state cabinet has decided to hand over 1 acre land to Tripura Gramin Bank free of cost for setting up Rural Self-employment Training Institute at Bishramganj in Sepahijala district. Divulging the news the education minister Rata Lal Nath during a press conference at the state secretariat yesterday said, this 1 acre land to be given to Tripura Gramin Bank is in Amtali Mouja of Bishalgarh subdivision and the current price of the said land is Rs. 37.50 lakh. He said, the state government is giving priority to self-employment youths. At the same time the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has also emphasized on establishment of one such centre in every district of the country.

The minister also informed, the present state government has imparted training to 2,535 youths in the 2019-20 financial year. These trained youth will also be prioritized while giving bank loans. At present UBI, Udaipur branch, SBI at Kumarghat and Ambassa, Canara Bank and Syndicate Bank in Agartala have started Rural Self-Employment Training Institute. For establishing the institute at Bishramganj the central government would provide Rs. 1 crore to the state government, informed the education minister.

## **Health camp schedule of Jampuijala**

Health camps have started by Takarjala community health centres at different places of Jampuijala subdivision. Health care facilities are being provided to the common people through these camps to prevent and treat malaria, dengue, diarrhoea etc. seasonal diseases. The first camp of the series has started yesterday at Takarjala market yesterday. As per schedule health camps will be held at Begunbari Anganwadi centre in Bardhaman Thakurpara of East Takarjala ADC village on May 19, at Farm market of East Ratanpur ADC village on May 23, at Saranjay Sardarpara of Jampuijala ADC village on May 24, at Ujan Ghaniamara sub-centre of Ujan Ghaniamara ADC village on May 26, at Gangaram Malsom Para of Hachuk Khuriaw ADC village on May 27, at Madhya Ghaniamara ADC village health sub-centre on May 29 and at Pekuarjala ADC village health sub-centre on May 30.

Similarly health camps will be held at Gayarampara Anganwadi centre of Prabhapur ADC village on June 2, at Sachulang Hati of West Ratanpur ADC village on June 5, at Bidhibazar sub-centre of Killa Verma ADC village on June 9, at Bijoynandi Para Anganwadi centre of Ujan Pathaliaghat ADC village on June 10, at Hirapur SB School of Hirapur ADC village on June 16, at Doharam para Anganwadi

centre of Amrendranagar ADC village on June 19, at Sombar Baazar of Sankuma Bari ADC village on June 20, at Gahiram Para Anganwadi centre of Tuisikamuk ADC village on June 23, and at Sankatrampara of Jampuijala ADC village on June 27. Every health camp will start at 11 am. Dr. Gobinda Reang, officer-in-charge of Takarjala community health centre has informed this.

### **Over 36 lakh mandays generated under MGNREGA in North district**

During the current financial year a total of 36,21,202 mandays have been generated in eight blocks of North Tripura district under MGNREGA. For this purpose an amount of Rs. 69,5,70,784 has been spent. Renovation of rural roads, earth leveling, plantation etc. activities have been done under the scheme. With this achievement 91,271 people have benefited in the district. This information has been given from the office of the district magistrate and collector, North Tripura district.

5,15,977 mandays have been generated in Kadamtala block at the cost of Rs. 9,90,67,584; 5,26,624 mandays have been generated in Kalachera block at the cost of Rs. 10,11,11,808; 4,37,658 mandays have been generated in Laljuri block at the cost of Rs. 8, 40, 30, 336; and 3,07,012 mandays have been generated in Panisagar block at the cost of Rs. 5,89,47,264.
