It is worth mentioning that the 'Statue of Unity' built at the cost of about Rs. 2332 crore is 182 metre tall. It is made of 18,500 tonne reinforcement steel and 6000 tonne structure steel. Elevators will be available to climb up the statue to a certain level so that surroundings can be viewed. A viewers' gallery with a capacity of 200 people at a time will be there. Apart from this, Sardar Patel Museum will be developed with 40,000 documents and 2000 photo frames.
