Cash crop plantation in Dhalai district: many families benefited

Various horticultural cash crop plantations have been raised by the office of deputy director of Dhalai district of horticulture and soil conservation department for more than 600 poor families of Dhalai district during the current financial year. Under the scheme mango plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 30 families, betel nut plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 120 families, lemon plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 40 families, Musambi plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 40 families of Manu block have been raised.

Mango plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 10 families, betel nut plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 80 families, lemon plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 20 families and musambi plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 20 families of Chhamanu block have been raised, 16 families have benefited under the scheme in Domburnagar block. Betel nut plantation in 24 hectare land has been raised for the beneficiaries. Betel nut plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 8 families and lemon plantation in 0.5 hectare land for each of 8 families of Raishvabari block have been raised. Under the scheme betel nut plantation in 27 hectare land for 54 families. lemon plantation in 18.5 hectare land for 37 families and mango plantation in 13 hectare land for 26 families have been raised. On the other hand, betel nut plantation in 0.5 hectare land for 110 families of Ganganagar block has been raised. Betel nut plantation in 12 hectare land has been raised for 11 families of Salema block. The office of director of Dhalai deputy district horticulture and soil conservation has informed this.
