

C.M on review meeting of Swadesh Darshan, flagship project of Tourism department

Tourism industry can be an important sector to economic progress of the state. An initiative has to be taken to attract the tourists through beautification and development of famous tourists places of the state. Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb said this after review meeting of Swadesh Darshan, flagship project of Tourism department at conference hall of Secretariat. Special Secretary of Tourism department Kiran Gittee informed in the review meeting that total Rs 99 crore 59 lakh has been sanctioned for Swadesh Darshan-1 project. Development work of different tourist places of Agartala, Shepahijala, Melagarh, Udaipur, Amarpur, Tirthamukh, Mandirghat, Narkel Kunja, Dombur, Gandachhara and Ambassa has been started under the scheme. Moreover, Rs 65 crore has been sanctioned for Swadesh Darshan-2 Project. Development work of different tourist places of

Surmachhara, Unakoti, Jampuihill, Gunabati, Bhubaneshwar temple, Matabari, Neermahal, Boxanagar, Chottakhala, Pilak and Abhagachhara is going on. Chief Minister instructed to finish the initiative for launching of paddle boat in Shepahijala, Narkel Kunja and Chhabimura. He also instructed to take plan to build up infrastructural development of Tirthamukh. Chief Secretary Manoj Kumar, Commissioner of AMC Dr. Shailesh Kumar Jadav and other officers of Tourism department were present in the review meeting.

DM also added that those farmers have availed loan through KCC they can also get loan for animal husbandry and fish cultivation in necessary.
