## **Regional Saras Mela concluded : goods worth Rs. 90 lakh sold**

Twelve days long 14<sup>th</sup> Regional Saras Mela concluded yesterday. This fair was started

from 2 January at Agartala International Fair & Exhibition ground situated at Hapania. In association with Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India the fair was organized by Rural Development Department, Govt. of Tripura.
