

Administrative camp in Laungansom village

An administrative team headed by the D.M of South Tripura district Debapriya Bardhan recently visited Laungansom ADC village of Bakafa block. Additional D.M Suresh Chandra Das, SDM of Shantirbazar subdivision Arghya Saha, BDO of Bakafa block Rupam Das alongwith district level officers of various departments were present in the team. The administrative team visited Laungansom health Sub-centre, 4 Anganwadi centres, roads under construction by PWD etc. After the tour, D.M alongwith the officers of various departments interacted with local people at the premises of Gobindabari High School. D.M instructed the officers of the concerned departments regarding various issues raised by the local people particularly related to drinking water, communication, power etc. On the other hand, 80 applications for PRTC, 65 applications for ST certificate and 45 applications for marriage certificates were received. 29 income certificates had been issued on urgent application basis. Health department provided medicine after medical checkup of 55 persons. Animal resources development department provided medicine to the animal-rearers

for treatment of 250 domestic animals-birds.

Kaskau Mai Khlungmu Hadaigiri festival-2019 was held at Malancha Nivas of Kunjaban, Agartala in befitting manner on October 13. The chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb inaugurated the two-day festival jointly organized by State Government, Brue Mathoha (Council of Kaskau and Rai of Reang, Tripura) and Tripura royal dynasty. Former MP Rajmata Bibhu Kumari Devi, MLA Promod Reang, chief secretary U Venkateshwarlau , PCCF Alind Rastogi, secretary of ICA department , Dalpaties of Reang community , wife of chief minister Niti Deb and other distinguished persons were present in the programme. Administrative team visited Shyamraichhara village

An administrative team headed by D.M of Dhalai district recently visited Shyamraichhara ADC village of Durgachowmuhan block for inspection of various development works. At first, D.M Govekar Mayur Ratilal visited Nanda Kumar Debbarma para Anganwadi centre. He discussed on health, nutrition and immunization of children of the Anganwadi centre. He instructed DWS department to take initiative to supply drinking water into the Anganwadi centre. Later on, D.M and other officers visited orange, betel nut and banana plantations of the beneficiaries being implemented under MGNREGA and Horticulture department.

It is also mentionable that the tribal people have done plantations over *patta* land. After the tour, the administrative team interacted with medical staffs of the

Durai Shyamraichhara Health Sub-centre regarding medical service and an administrative meeting was held at Shyamraichhara S.B School. District and subdivision level officers of various departments were present in the meeting. D.M set a future guideline after review of various problems of this area after consulting with local people. He instructed the concerned line departments to finish work within due time. Decision had been taken in the meeting to install mini deep tube well at Khirod para. A road will be constructed along the 4 K.M long road from airfield to the house of Anup Kumar Debbarma. A proposal for up gradation of Shyamraichhara S.B School to High School has been taken up. A boundary wall for the school will be constructed. The officers of agriculture, horticulture, fishery, power, animal resources development department discussed on future development schemes of the village. After the administrative meeting D.M visited newly constructed brooder house at Bamanchhara panchayat. He interacted with the women of Self Help Groups. The officers of animal resources development department had also discussed on utilization of brooder for maintaining livelihood.
