Power tillers at ubsidized rate provided in Gournagar agri-subdivision

Under National Mission for Agriculture Extension Technology scheme, total 100 power tillers have been provided in Gournagar agri-subdivision during the 2018-19 financial year. Among them, 60 persons of Gournagar block, 26 persons of Chandipur block and 11 persons of Kumarghat block have received power tillers. Power tiller at subsidized rate of Rs

75,000 has been provided to each beneficiary under the scheme. Agriculture superintendent of Gournagar agrisubdivision Aniruddha Bhattacharjee has informed this.

Assistance provided to 22 fishermen for pisci-culture in Bishalgarh subdivision

Various assistances will be provided by the fishery department to 22 tribal fishermen of different blocks of Bishalgarh subdivision during the current financial year. Six fish farmers of the subdivision will receive 3200 different species of young fish, lime, oil cake and fish feed under integrated fish cultivation project of the fishery department. Under this scheme, three pigs will be provided to each beneficiary. Rs 41,500 will be spent for each beneficiary fisherman. On the other hand, 1,440 fingerlings, lime, oil cake, fish feed and medicine will be provided to each of 16 tribal fishermen under demonstrative fish cultivation scheme. Rs 20,000 will be spent for each beneficiary fisherman. The office of the Bishalgarh fishery superintendent has informed this.

Administrative tour in East Pilak village

Under the aegis of South Tripura district administration a team of officers of district and subdivisional level visited East Pilak ADC village under Jolaibari block recently. The team led by the ADM, South Tripura Suresh Chandra Das and SDM, Santirbazar Arghya Saha had visited four Anganwadi centres, Ishanbari JB School, East Pilak High School, and health subcentres. They had, during the visit, enquired about various activities going on in the area and interacted with the students.

Later on a health camp was organized by Santirbazar the subdivisional administration. On the part of the health department free medicines were distributed among 175 patients after health check-up. The subdivisional administration also received applications for 250 PRC, 195 ST and 111 marriage certificates. Income certificates were issued to 95 people and 420 people were snapped for AADHAAR card. In addition, 398 animals and birds were treated and given medicines from the animal resources development department.
