



### **Small Savings collection goes beyond 6 crore mark in Gomati district**

An amount of Rs. 6, 90, 18, 758 has been collected under Small Savings Scheme in Gomati district till October of the current financial year. The small savings officer also informed that during the said period collection in Udaipur subdivision has been Rs. 5, 77, 19, 300; in Amarpur subdivision has been Rs. 90, 97, 334 and in Karbook subdivision collection has been Rs. 22, 2, 124.

### **Paddy procurement at MSP begins in Khowai**

In accordance with the government initiative purchase of paddy at minimum support price has started in Khowai subdivision on December 16. FCI's Ganaki godown has purchased 235 quintal paddy from the farmers at minimum support price, informed the chief inspector of food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department Babul Chandra Das. Under the scheme per quintal paddy is priced at RS. 1750.

### **Administrative & health camp in Ratannagar ADC village on December 19**

### **Target for cultivation of winter vegetables set in West district**

Target for cultivation of winter seasonal vegetables has been set at 160 ha. area for West Tripura district under MIDH scheme of the horticulture and soil conservation department. Under this scheme already vegetable has cultivated over 30 ha. area in Dukli block; over 20 ha. in Moanpur block; over 20 ha. in Bamutia block; over 15 ha. in Lefunga block. The cultivated vegetables include potato, tomato, cauliflower, cabbage and brinjal. Similar activities are going on in Jirania block over 20 ha.; in Belbari block over 10 ha.; in Mandai block over 10 ha.; and in Hezamara block over 10 ha. ### **Subsidised power tiller distributed among 29 beneficiaries in Jampuijala**
