

## **School renovated under Panchayat development fund**

Seven schools have been renovated under Panchayat Development Fund in Gomati Zilla Parishad during the current financial year. These schools are Holikhet High School, Gowalgao High School, Gokulpur High School, Totabari High School, Powermura High School, Khilpara H.S School and Hirapur High School. Rs one lakh has been spent for renovation of each school and Rs 7 lakh in total has been spent. Moreover, Kitchens in 23 Anganwadi centres of 4 non-ADC blocks have been renovated at the cost of Rs 4 lakh 50 thousand. One canal and one road at Rangutia gram panchayat of Amarpur block have been renovated under PDF of Zilla Parishad. Rs 6 lakh 20 thousand has been spent for this purpose. The office of Gomati Zilla Parishad has informed this.

## **Administrative camp at Vidyabil High School of Khowai**

An administrative cum health camp was organized by Khowai Sub-divisional administration at premises of Vidyabil High School of Tulashikhar block on March 12. Chairman of East Karangichhara ADC village Barendra Debbarma, SDM of Khowai subdivision Asit Kumar Das were

present in the programme. Moreover, the officers of education, health, PWD, DWS, social welfare and social education, animal resources development, power

and I.C.A departments were present in the programme. The officers interacted with local people regarding development of this area. Administration received applications for issuing 46 PRTC, 52 ST certificate and 30 marriage certificates. Health department provided medicine after medical checkup of 35 persons. Moreover, A.R.D.D distributed medicine for domestic animals and birds.

## **Agri-schemes implemented in Boxanagar agri-subdivision**

Financial assistance under PM Kishan Samman Nidhhi Scheme has been provided by Boxanagar agri-subdivision office to 2341 farmers during 2019-2020 financial year. Kishan credit card has been

provided to 2140 farmers under Kishan Samman Nidhi. 168 MT paddy has been purchased at MSP during Kharif season. Thus, 128 farmers have benefited. 204 farmers have been registered under PM Fasal Bima Yojana. 8 new ponds have been excavated and 9 ponds have been renovated. 9 pump sets have been provided to the farmers for irrigation purpose. Moreover, 15 power tillers been provided at subsidized rate. Agricultural instruments, weeding machine, power tiller, thresher, pump set for irrigation purpose and other instruments have been provided to Agriculture Development Cooperative Samiti and Rahimpur Agriculture Development Cooperative Samiti. Rs 10 lakh has been spent for each Samiti. High yielding hybrid paddy is being cultivated through SRI system in 215 hectare land during *boro* crop. Superintendent of Boxanagar agri-subdivision office Manish Das has informed this.

#### **Assistance for animal husbandry in Dhalai district**

Assistance has been provided by Dhalai District animal resources development office to 20 families with the fund from SC welfare department. Thus, 5 families each

from Ambassa, Salema, Chhamanu and Manu blocks have benefited. 6 piglets alongwith feed, medicine and other items used for pig farming have been provided to each beneficiary under the scheme. Rs 97 thousand has been spent for each beneficiary. On the other hand, hybrid goats have been distributed among 5 families each from Ambassa, Salema, Chhamanu and Manu blocks. 10 goats have been provided to each family. The office of the deputy director of Dhalai district animal resources development has informed this.

#### **Assistance provided under PM Kishan Samman Nidhi in Belonia**

Till now 5131 beneficiaries in 1st installment, 5055 beneficiaries in 2nd installment and 4837 beneficiaries in 3rd installment under PM Kishan Samman Nidhi have availed money in Hrishyamukh block. On the other hand, 2150 beneficiaries in 1st installment, 2121 beneficiaries in 2nd installment and 2037 beneficiaries in 3rd installment have availed money in Bharatchandranagar block. The Belonia office of the deputy director of agriculture and farmers welfare department has informed this.
