New drinking water bottling plant at Haowaibari

A drinking water bottling plant of M.M. Beverage Manufacturing Company at Haowaibari of Teliamura subdivision was commissioned on September 17. The chief minister Blplab Kumar Deb was present there to inaugurate this bottling brand called 'Jhil', in presence of other dignitaries like chief whip of Tripura Legislative Assembly Kalyani Roy, chief regional manager of UBI Anand Kumar, chairperson of Teliamura Municipal Council Nitin Kumar Saha.

Addressing the gathering the chief said these days this type of ventures are creating more jobs. Such ventures must be encouraged. Established at the cost of Rs. 1.90 crore this manufacturing unit will give jobs to 35 persons and it is capable of bottling 8000 litre purified water. Appreciating this type of venture the chief minister also said, with the coming of 'Single window system' now NOC could be availed for 19 departments from TIDC office within one month. Just few days back under Pradhan Mantri Sampad Yojana Rs. 28 crore bank loan with 50 per cent subsidy was distributed for setting up rice mill, spices factory, pickle factory etc..

The chief minister also informed, under Ayushman Bharat health insurance facility was ensured for 3.57 lakh families at the cost of Rs. 9 crore. Free health service is being provided to Antyoday families. By March 30, 2020 70 families of the state will be brought under Ayushman Bharat. On this occasion Keshab Paul, head of the manufacturing company handed over a

cheque of Rs. 50001 for chief minister's relief fund.

High yielding aman paddy cultivation under SRI system at Padmabil

High yielding *aman* paddy in SRI System is being cultivated in 774 hectare land under Padmabil agri-subdivision during the current financial year. Rs 3,918 per hectare land totaling Rs 30 lakh 36 thousand 440 will be spent for this purpose. Moreover, high yielding *aman* paddy is being cultivated in 320 hectare land.
