





injury and stricture, penile injury etc. There is proposal for introducing Super Specialty courses on Urology (Mch. Urology) and kidney transplant when other allied departments (CTVS, Nephrology) are made operational.

In the Plastic Surgery Department, hand surgery (trauma and defects), posttraumatic tissue and skin loss coverage, birth defects like cleft lip and palate and hand deformities, post cancer surgery defect correction. burn deformitv correction and AV fistula for haemo-dialysis operations could be done. There is proposal for introducing Super Specialty course in future in this department also. It is noteworthy that these two departments would be served by six super specialty doctors with four in urology and two in plastic surgery Total number of beds available in these two departments is 22.

Terming the as historic in the health sector of Tripura the Health Minister expressed conviction that these two departments would be able to provide critical services in future. He also hoped that with this many doctors hailing from this state would make up their mind to come back to the state by responding to the invitation offered earlier. MLA Dr. Dilip Das also spoke on this occasion.

Mukhyamantri B.Ed. Anuprerona Yojana sets off from this academic year

The Government of Tripura has launched the 'Mukhyamantri B.Ed Anuprerona Yojana' from this academic year, the education department has informed through a press release today. As per the order of the Chief Minister the banks have been intimated to this effect and applications for availing benefits of this scheme have been invited from the willing candidates within October 15.

However, pre-condition for this benefit will be the course being pursued has to be in any of the institutes recognized by NCTE or NAAC-graded/ Quality Council of Indiacertified and the students availing this facility should have secured at least 50 per cent marks (45 per cent in case of ST/SC) in graduation. The tenure of loan will be a maximum of 2 years and amount of loan ceiling will be Rs. 1 lakh per year. The subsidy will be applicable for four years from the date of approval or till securing a government job, whichever is earlier. The scheme will be in force for five years i. e. upto 2023 and total students to come under this scheme will be 5000.

From the 2018-19 academic year this loan would be disbursed and if in the first year required number of students are not available then the left-over number of students would be taken in the next four years. Participating banks are – Allahabad Bank, Andhra Bank, Bank of Baroda, Bank of India, Bank of Maharashtra, Kanada Bank, Central Bank of India, Corporation Bank, Dena Bank, India Bank, IDBI, Indian Overseas Bank, Oriental Bank of Commerce, Punjab and Sind Bank, Punjab National
