Workshop held on Agar Cultivation extraction of Agar oil and its trade

Agar tree is the State Tree of Tripura. In order to promote its cultivation, a one-day workshop on Agar cultivation, extraction of Agar oil and its trade was held in the JICA Project building at Agartala on

The workshop was a part of the consultation process which initiated by Tripura Forest Department for identifying the issues and opportunities to develop this high potential sector for the benefit of people interested in agar cultivation for the prosperity of the people of the State. The workshop was organized by NTFP Centre of Excellence, a recently created Autonomous Body for systematic development of NTFP sector in the State in collaboration with Forest Research Centre for Livelihood Extension, a unit of Rain Forest Research Institute (RFRI), Jorhat.

Minister for Forest & Tribal Welfare department Mevar Kumar Jamatia inaugurated the workshop in presence of PCCF & HoFF, Tripura Dr. Alind Rastogi, Director of RFRI Jorhat Dr. RSC Jayraj and Senior scientists from Botanical Survey of India and officials from Assam, Tripura Forest Department and 74 participants from amongst agar growers, traders and other stakeholders from Assam, Uttar Pradesh and Tripura.

The participants discussed the conservation of wild varieties of Agar trees, opportunities in the world Agar market, the statutory requirements that are required to be complied with for promoting the sustainable harvesting of agar, the technology available for artificially inducing

agarwood formation in trees of cultivated variety, simplification of process harvesting trees from non-forest land to encourage its cultivation in complete detail. The scientist from RFRI gave a live demonstration of scientific method of inoculation in the Agar plantation. Experiences were also shared among the participants. Issues discussed also included the status of cultivation and extraction of Agarwood in Assam, production of Agar and extraction of Agar oil, status of Agar in the wild and its future prospect.

The Forest Minister Mevar Kumar Jamatia advised the Department to set up an Agar Conservation Foundation at Agartala under NTFP Centre of Excellence and work to assimilate entire information on all related processes. The foundation would work as single window source for providing any help relating to agar cultivation, processing, trade and export and sustainable management. PCCF Dr. Rastogi assured the participants that a sincere attempt would be made to simply and streamline the process in compliance with CITES norms for developing the sector.

Sadar Sub-division level merit award distribution to the ST students held

Pradhan Mantri Fasal BimaYojana in Bakafa Agriculture Subdivision

Total 400 hectare paddy field has been covered under high risk zone of Bakafa Agriculture Subdivision of Shantirbazar Subdivision at free of cost bima yojana under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana during this current agriculture season. Under the scheme 200 hectare paddy field of Jolaibari block and 200 hectare paddy field of Bokafa block have been covered under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana. On the other hand, 105 hectare potato field of Jolaibari block and 85 hectare potato field of Bokafa block have been covered under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana. Army recruitment Rally at Agartala during 21-25 February, 2019

Army recruitment rally will be held at Dasaratha Deb State Sports Complex, Agartala scheduled from 21 February to 25 February, 2019. Candidates of all districts of the state can participate in the rally for recruitment of Soldier (General Duty), Soldier (Technical), Soldier (Nursing Assistant), Soldier (Clerk / Storekeeper /

Inventory Management) and Soldier (Trades man) categories. The recruitment schedule to be tentatively followed is 21 Feb, 2019 for candidates of West Tripura and South Tripura districts, 22 Feb, 2019 for Sepahijala and Gomati districts, 23 Feb,2019 for Dhalai, Unakoti, North Tripura & Khowai districts who can participate accordingly. However, final schedule will be published at a later stage based on registration on number of candidates and will be published accordingly. Screening medical and till 25 documentation will continue Februaruy, 2019. Every candidate can participate in the rally only once. Eligibility in terms of age for participation in the rally is 17 years 6 months to 21 years for Soldier (General duty) and 17 years 6 months to 23 years for all other categories. Age for recruitment is calculated as on 1st October, 2018. Candidates have to apply for participation in the recruitment rally through online at first.
