

Preparatory meeting on Teacher's Day held in Dharmanagar

Subdivision level Teacher's Day will be observed on 5 September in Dharmanagar by Education Department and in association with Dharmanagar Municipal Council. Subdivision level main programme will be organized at Vivekananda Sardha Satabarshiki Bhaban of Dharmanagar. Retired teachers will be felicitated in the programme organized on this occasion. Apart from this, colorful cultural programme will also be organized. These decisions have been taken in the preparatory meeting on Teacher's Day observance held on 18 August in Bir Bikram Institution of Dharmanagar. The meeting was chaired by the Chairperson of Dharmanagar Municipal Council Shakti Bhattacharjee in presence of the Deputy Speaker of Tripura Legislative Assembly Biswa Bandhu Sen, retired teacher Dipak Bhattacharjee, prominent social activist Alokesh Aditya along with the District Education Officer and Headmasters of various schools. One Steering Committee and two sub-committees have been constituted to make this subdivision level Teacher's Day observance programme a success. The Deputy Speaker of Tripura Legislative Assembly Biswa Bandhu Sen would be the Patron of this subdivision level Teacher's Day observance

programme. Moreover, the Chairperson of Dharmanagar Municipal Council Shakti Bhattacharjee has been nominated as the Chairman of the Steering Committee and the Inspector of Schools, Dharmanagar Sujit Rudrapaul has been nominated as Convener.

Administrative camp to be held at Shikaribari on 21 August

Moreover, during this period 98 thousand 119 person days have been generated in 20 ADC villages of Dasda block under Kanchanpur Subdivision. Under this programme 7 thousand 576 persons of 6 thousand 263 families of this block area have got works. In this purpose an amount of Rs.1 crore 73 lakh 67 thousand 63 has been spent for various development works.

Workshop on Disaster Management held in Dharmanagar

officer from Water resources department Dibyojyoti Nath and Dr. Subrata Biswas took part in the workshop. At the beginning of the workshop two minutes silence was observed in memory of the departed former Prime Minister of India Atal Bihari Vajpayee.

Assistance for vegetable cultivation in West Tripura District

Seeds of various vegetables are being distributed at free of cost by Horticulture and Soil conservation department among 2,461 families of farmers' in West Tripura District who were affected by the recent flood. An amount of Rs. 14.77 lakh would be spent for this purpose. Mentioning this officer of Horticulture and Soil conservation office of West Tripura District has also informed that flood affected families under this district would be provided assistance under this scheme out of these, 188 families of Jirania block, 28 families of Belbari block, 390 families of Old Agartala block, 20 families of Mandai block, 525 families of Mohanpur block, 70 families of Lefunga block, 415 families of Bamutia block and 825 families of Hezamara block. Meanwhile, various vegetables seeds have already been provided among 1,605 families of West Tripura district.
