Over 17,000 mandays generated in Sepaipara ADC Village

A total of 17,248 mandays have been generated in Sepaipara ADC village of Lefunga block under MGNREGA, thereby giving 43.12 days of employment in average to the job card holders. Under the scheme soil leveling, construction of raw drain, renovation of drains etc. works have been executed. For this an amount of Rs. 29.00 lakh has been spent. In addition, under Swachch Bharat Mission toilets have (rural) pucca been constructed for 11 families with a unit cost of Rs. 12,000 totalling an expenditure of Rs. 1.32 lakh. Village secretary has informed this.

Toilets constructed in Padmabil under Swachch Bharat Mission

Under Swachch Bharat Kosh target was set for construction of 379 pucca toilets in different ADC villages of Padmabil block during the current financial year. Already construction of all the toilets has been completed. Target was set for construction of another 2040 toilets in the block area under Swachch Bharat Mission.

Already construction of 1575 toilets has been completed. On the other hand, under Swachch Bharat Mission (Rural) with World Bank finance, 150 toilets have been constructed. This information has been given from the Padmabil RD block.

Assistance for animal husbandry in Teliamura

During the current financial year financial assistance has been provided by the resources development animal department to 147 be7neficiaries for piggery and livestock poultry farming. Under Rashtriya Krishi Vikash Yojana, an amount of Rs. 5.82 lakh has been provided to six animal rearers Teliamura nad Kalyanpur block for piggery. Additionally, for poultry farming Rs. 5000 has been given to each of 27 beneficiaries from Teliamura and Kalyanpur block totaling an expenditure of Rs. 2.50 lakh. Under Forest Rights Act, Rs. 6000 has been given to each of 91 beneficiaries for piggery incurring a total expenditure of Rs. 5.46 lakh. Assistant director of Teliamura animal resource development office Uttam Saha has informed this.

Notification regarding Polytechnic Diploma course through common entrance examination

In this year, selection of students in various polytechnics under DHE for Diploma in Engineering will be done through common entrance examination followed bv on-line counseling. Registration will be done online through the website www.highereducation.tripura.govt.in by clicking the link of 'Diploma Engineering Entrance Examination Tripura 2020'. There will be no hard copy of application form. Registration fee for all candidates other than BPL candidates is Rs 350 and registration fee for BPL candidates is Rs 200. Candidates will be selected on the basis of merit position in the entrance examination named 'Diploma as **Engineering Entrance Examination Tripura** 2020 (DEEET-2020)'.

It will be a Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) based examination. Total mark will be 400 fixed for Mathematics, Physical Science /Science and English. Negative marking system will be there. Compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of examination will be allowed to PH

candidates. Entire syllabus of the examination will be available on www.highereducation.tripura.govt.in. The syllabus is based on Madhyamik syllabus of TBSE, CBSE and other equivalent boards. Medium of the question papers is in English and Bengali both. Details regarding the entrance examination will be available in the website www.highereducation.tripura.govt.in.

Locations of entrance examination venue will be Agartala, Udaipur, Ambassa, Dharmanagar and Belonia. Based on merit position in the entrance examination, counseling will be done online based on the performances given by the candidates the online portal. After online counseling documents verification students will be done in respective institute under the supervision Principal / Principal (I/C) of Polytechnics. For admission the students should have 35% in aggregate in Madhyamik examination from **TBSE** other or (As equivalent boards per **AICTE** guideline). There will be no age limit (As per AICTE guideline). Candidate should be permanent resident of Tripura. Students appearing in Madhyamik examination2020 can also apply. Online registration is commencing from March 20, 2020 and closing date of registration is April 3, 2020. Tentative date of examination is May 3, 2020. Other important dates will be notified in due course of time in local newspaper. The Higher Education Department has informed this in a statement.

Assistance for pisci culture in Dhalai district

House has been constructed by Dhalai District Fisheries Office for total 460 fish farmer families of 8 blocks of the district under Blue Revolution scheme during 2019-20 financial year. Under the scheme 20 families in Ambassa block, 10 families in Ganganagar block, 170 families in Domburnagar block, 150 families in Raishyabari block, 30 families in Salema block, 30 families in Durgachowmuhani block, 20 families in Chhamanu block 30 families in Manu block will be benefited.
