Administrative camp held at Dasharathnagar ADC village

An administrative-cum-health camp was organized jointly by South Tripura district administration Sabroom and divisional administration at Manaigroom J.B School of Dasharathnagar ADC village of Powang bari block of Sabroom subdivision on October 18 to provide administrative facilities to rural people. D.M of South Tripura district Debapriya Bardhan, SDM of Sabroom subdivision Biplab Das, BDO of Powangbari block Amit Karmakar. Chairman Kumar Dasharathnagar Village Committee Tapan Kumar, vice-chairman Sambhu Tripura, DCM Paritosh Debbarma and officers of various departments were present in the camp.

Interaction took place in the camp related to various problems of local people and development schemes. D.M instructed officers of the concerned departments to solve the problems of local people immediately. Various development schemes of power, PWD, social welfare and social education, health, DWS, agriculture and farmers welfare. PWD (WR) and fisheries departments were discussed in the meeting. Health

department provided required medicine after medical checkup of 57 patients. Animal resources development department provided required medicine for treatment of 202 cattle and birds. Sabroom subdivisional administration received applications for issuing of 50 PRTC, 51 ST certificates and 8 income certificates.

Development activities in ADC Villages of Killa block

Various development schemes under MGNREGA are being implemented in ADC Villages of Killa block. 25,608 mandays have been generated at the cost of Rs 49 lakh 16 thousand 736 in Killa ADC village of the block. 24,589 mandays have been generated in Kachigung ADC village. Under the scheme, water reservoir, forestry and orchard have been raised. Rs 47 lakh 21 thousand 88 has been spent for this purpose. 17,113 mandays have been generated at the cost of Rs 32 lakh 85 thousand 696 in Jainbari ADC village. The office of D.M, Gomati district has informed this.

SRI paddy cultivation Dhalai district

Hybrid paddy under SRI system in 3330 hectare land and high yielding paddy in 3685 hectare land have been cultivated in Dhalai district during this agriculture season. Rs 9 thousand has been spent in both sectors. Under the scheme, hybrid paddy has been cultivated over 975 hectare land and high yielding paddy has been cultivated over 905 hectare land in Durga Chowmuhani block. Similarly hybrid paddy over 875 hectare land and high yielding paddy over 560 hectare land in Salema block; hybrid paddy over 430 hectare land and high yielding paddy over 640 hectare land in Ambassa block; hybrid paddy over 250 hectare land and high yielding paddy over 450 hectare land in Chhamanu block; hybrid paddy over 625 hectare land and high yielding paddy over 1020 hectare land in Manu block; hybrid paddy over 125 hectare land and high yielding paddy over 80 hectare land in Domburnagar block; hybrid paddy over 50 hectare land and high yielding paddy over 30 hectare land in Raishyabari block have been cultivated. The office of the deputy director of Dhalai district agriculture and farmers welfare department has informed this.

Assistance provided for Pisci culture in Udaipur

Assistance has been provided to 32 tribal fish farmers of Udaipur subdivision under demonstrative fish cultivation scheme during the current financial year. 8 fish farmers each of Tepania, Matabari, Kakraban and Killa blocks will benefited under the scheme. 2000 fingerlings, 100 Kg lime, 100Kg oil cake, 200 Kg floating fish feed, 200 Kg soluble fish feed and required medicine have been provided to each fish farmer. Rs. 6 lakh 40 thousand will be spent under the scheme. The office of the Uaipur fisheries superintendent has informed this.

Training provided to animal rearers in Laxmilunga panchayat

One day training camp and a programme on distribution of layer birds was organized by the veterinary dispensary of Ushabazar under animal resources development department at the premises of North Laxmilunga panchayat office of Bamutia block on October 18. After completion of the training 45 layer birds, bird feed, cage, pot of water and required medicine have been provided to each of 32 families of the panchayat under poultry scheme of C.S.S.
