One M-III tube well has been installed in Bhubanchhara High School and Kanchanchhara high school. Rs 1 lakh 11 thousand has been spent for installation of each M-II tube well. Moreover, one M-III tube well is being installed in Chalubari high school at the cost of Rs 1 lakh 11 thousand. One M-II tube well is being installed in Madhav Chandra H.S School in Chhailengta block at the cost of Rs 1 lakh 11 thousand. The office of Dhalai district education officer has informed this.

### **Fortnight long leprosy detection programme**

Leprosy detection programme, Parashmoni is being introduced first time

in the state for eradication of leprosy. This programme will continue from August 26 to September 9. Mission Director Aditi Majumdar has informed this at conference hall of National Health mission office on August 23. She informed that the aim of the programme is to identify leprosy patients and for that they have to be provided proper medical service. During the days of the programme, joint team of ASHA workers and volunteers will visit door to door for identification of the patients.

Under the programme, health check up of every family member aged above 2 years will be done. After detection of the disease the affected patients will be sent to nearest health centre for proper medical advice. She also informed that total 7589 teams have been formed for conducting the programme smoothly in entire state. She also informed that treatment of 36 leprosy patients of the state is going on. Among them, condition of 16 patients is in grade-2 stage. Leprosy disease is curable completely through multi-drug therapy. This treatment is available in all health centres of the state. She appealed to all for cooperation to
