#### Administrative camp at Indramoni para: many people benefited

An administrative-cum-health camp was organized by Kumarghat subdivisional administration at Indramoni para J.B School of Rajkandi village in Kumarghat block on September 20 to provide various administrative facilities to the people of remote areas. Before starting the camp SDM Sandeep Cakraborty, BDO Mithun Das Chowdhury and officers of various departments under the leadership of D.M of Unakoti district Rabindra Reang visited several schools, Anganwadi centres, girl's hostel, house constructed under PM Awas Yojana (rural).

During the tour, D.M. Sri Rabindra Reang interacted with local people and farmers of the village regarding road, power etc. of this area. He instructed the officers of the concerned department to take necessary initiative to solve the problems. Later on, an interaction meeting was held at the office of Rajkandi village with local people. The representatives of various departments highlighted various development schemes of their respective departments. 126 ST and 111 PRTC applications have been received in the camp. Income certificate has been issued to 32 persons on urgent application basis. Health department

provided required medicine after health checkup of 32 persons. Blood test of five persons had been done. On the other hand, preventive medicines have been provided to the animal rearers by the animal resources development department after health check-up of 501 domestic animals-birds in the camp.

# Poshan Maah programme in Kamalpur

The office of the subdivisional health officer has informed that hemoglobin test of teenagers and pregnant women had been done under the programme. The test was done in 15 health sub-centres and Marachhara PHC of Durga Chowmuhani block. Hemoglobin test was done for a total of 115 persons under the special programme.

# Distribution of power tillers among 128 people of West Tripura district

128 power tillers were distributed by the office of West district horticulture and soil conservation among the farmers of various agri-subdivisions, blocks of West Tripura district and Agartala Municipal council area. These power tillers had been given to the farmers on subsidized rate of Rs 75,000 under MIDH scheme.
