### **Power connections provided to 629 BPL families at Chandipur Block**

Till the first week of June, power connections under Deendayal Upadhyay Gram Jyoti Yojana were provided to 629 BPL families of 60 habitations under Chandipur Block. Target has been set up to provide power connections among 1033 BPL families through this programme. Apart from this, keeping ahead the target for extension work of 39.77 km LT power lines in that block area, extension work of 30.92 km has been completed. Target was to extend 15.58 km in case of HT- line extension. Out of this extension work of 7.067 km has been completed. Moreover, keeping ahead the target to provide power connections in 30 remote areas of that block, 16 areas have been provided with power connections.

### **Renovation of various roads under Udaipur subdivision**

Under the aegis of PWD department renovation and maintenance works of damaged roads at various areas under Udaipur subdivision are going on.

Renovation work of the road stretching 6 km from East Kupilong to Raiya Malsom is in progress. An amount of Rs.15 Lakh 35 thousand has been estimated as expenditure for this purpose. Maintenance work of the road stretching 1.2 km from Amtali to Banduar is going on with an estimated cost of Rs.14 Lakh 42 thousand for this purpose. Renovation work of the road stretching 4.2 km from Bagma market to the house of Nepal Das of Garjanmura is in progress with an estimated cost of Rs.39 Lakh 63 thousand. Similarly, Maintenance work of the road stretching 8 km from Noabari to Pitra is going on with an estimated cost of Rs.15 Lakh 95 thousand for this purpose.
