Over 14,000 unorganised workers enrolled under PM-SYM in Tripura

The state government has played a pivotal role by enrolling over thousand beneficiaries in a single day throughout the state under the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Yojana (PM-SYM). With active participation of the field functionaries of the labour department so far more than 14,000 labourers of the unorganized sector have been brought under the scheme and the process of enrolment is going on quite well. The state government had decided that the building and other construction workers registered in the Tripura Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare (TB&OCWWB) shall be persuaded to come under the PM-SYM.

The PM-SYM was officially launched by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi at Ahmedabad in March, 2019. The unorganized workers ageing between 18-40 years are eligible to get enrolled under the PM-SYM with a monthly contribution of Rs. 55-200 and the government will remit a matching amount into their account. Prime objective behind scheme was to secure the rights of 42 crore unorganized workers and to benefit at least 10 crore in the next years to come. In Tripura the labour department played significant role implementation of this scheme in terms of

awareness generation among the works of unorganized sector and guiding them through Common Service Centres.

Administrative camp in Kakraban block
