

9865 Families in Sadar get free LPG connections

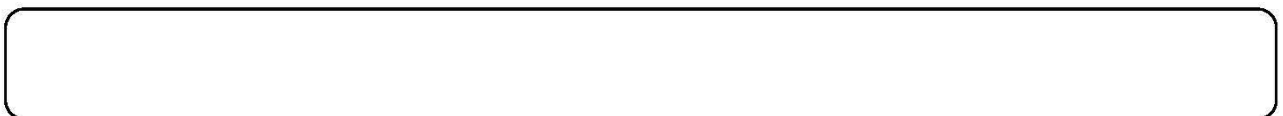
So far free LPG connections have been provided to 9865 families of Sadar subdivision under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana. Giving details of the information from the subdivisional food, civil supplies and consumers affairs department office it was informed that 4232 connections were given from Royal Brother Indane Service, Nandannagar, Agartala; 1449 connections from Satya Narayan Agency of Hapania; 1389 connections from Sahay Agency of Agartala; 791 connections from Sarala Agency; 112 connections from Capital Agency; 190 connections from Ashirvad Agency; 201 connections from Tripura State Co-operative Marketing Federation; 340 connections from Tripura Co-operative Federation Limited; 234 connections from RKS of Barjala; 438 connections from Gasco of Agartala; 70 connections from Gas O Flame and 419 connections from Baba Loknath Gas Agency of Sekerkote.

Good Governance Day observed

Present state government is working towards establishment of good governance. Launching of e-PDS, e-Tender, e-District are all initiatives

towards that direction, said the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating a mega blood donation camp at the office premises of Ranirbazar Municipal Council yesterday. He also said, the state government has taken several measures to make the state self-sufficient in milk production. With this objective in view the government has decided to provide 10,000 cows to 5,000 families. For this, loan will be arranged through ST/SC Corporation. Implementation of this scheme would not only pave the avenues of income generation but also ensure nutrition for people. MLA Sushanta Chowdhury also spoke on this occasion.

This blood donation camp was organized as a part of observance of Good Governance Day to mark the birth anniversary of former Prime Minister late Atal Behari Bajpayee. A public meeting was also held at Ranirbazar police station road on this occasion. Addressing the gathering there the Chief Minister informed, through e-PDS 2.5 lakh MT rice is being provided at Rs. 2. Moreover, procurement of paddy by the FCI at minimum support price of Rs. 17.50 per kg has started. In this system farmers would get profit of Rs. 5 – 5.50 per kg paddy. This very paddy will be used to



procurement centre has been opened in Sonamura subdivision. Moreover, one paddy collection centre has been opened in each block. 86 farmers of Boxanagar block, 109 farmers of Mohanbhog & Nalchar blocks, 69 farmers of Kathalia block had already registered their names with the agriculture department for selling of 367 MT paddy. Paddy will be purchased from the farmers of Boxsanagar, Kathalia, Mohanbhog and Nalchar blocks in a phased manner from the sonamura procurement centre. The process will continue upto 1st January, 2019. The representative of FCI informed that full payment of paddy would be deposited into the bank accounts of concerned farmers.

Permanent assets created in Charilam under through MGNREGA

Through MGNREGA so far 166 permanent assets have been created in Charilam block area. An amount of Rs. 1.41,517 mandays have been generated. Break-up of the mandays generated goes like this – 4997 mandays in Amtali village committee, 4952 mandays in Bangshibari village, 4196 mandays in Banshtali village, 1907 mandays in Bathanmura village, 4389 mandays in Chelikhala village, 1980 mandays in Dhariathal village, 1826 mandays in Padmanagar village, 2381 mandays in Bamnagar village, 4812

mandays in Rongmala village, and 4304 mandays in Sutarmura village. Among the panchayats picture of mandays goes like this – 12,557 mandays in Aralia panchayat, 6,268 mandays in Barjala panchayat, 7203 mandays in Bishramganj panchayat, 5,426 mandays in Brajapur panchayat, 5,573 mandays in Chesarmai panchayat, 20, 534 mandays in South Charilam, 6,477 mandays in Lalsingmura panchayat, 8,911 mandays in Madhya Brajapur panchayat, 7,422 mandays in Ramchera panchayat, 18,164 mandays in North Charilam panchayat and 7,165 mandays in North Brajapur panchayat.

Assistance to horti-farmers of Matabari & Tepania
