Many people benefit in administrative camp of Dhanichhara

Administrative and health camp was organized by Kumarghat subdivisional administration at Parbajoy para S.B School in South Dhanichhara village of Pachertal block on July 24. An interaction was held between representatives of various departments and local inhabitants regarding various facilities provided by the administration besides development of socio-economic livelihood of the local people. Thirty-nine applications for ST certificate and 125 applications for PRTC have been received in the camp. Income certificates have been provided to 35 persons. 37 persons have been provided required medicine after check-up. Blood test of three persons has been done. But, no malaria parasite has been found in blood samples of these persons. Medicine has been distributed among the animal rearers after health check-up of 200 animals and birds benefiting 42 families.

The representatives of health department informed that the patients suffering from malaria had been treated at hospital immediately after detection of the disease. DDT had been sprayed in this area. Moreover, an initiative will be taken up for distribution of mosquito net among the local people. The representative of agriculture department informed that there is a bright future for cultivation of pineapple at this area. SDM Sandip Chakraborty, chairman of the village Nandini Chakma, vice-chairman Shivaji Chakma, ZDO of North zone of TTADC Mahammad Ismail Mia, BDO of Pachertal block Shyamjoy Jamatia, DCM cum SDW Pradip Reang were present in the programme.

Over 100 farmers benefit through fruit cultivation in Tulashikhar block

A plan for cultivation of horticultural cash crop has been taken up by the agriculture & farmers' welfare department and horticulture and soil conservation departments in ADC villages of Tulashikhar block under MGNREGA during the current financial year. In the first phase, an initiative has been taken up for plantation of betel nut in 20 hectare land. 39 tribal farmers will be benefited under the scheme. Rs 27 lakh 79 thousand 700 will be spent for this purpose.
