He further added, till now an amount of Rs. 21 crore 60 Lakh has been sanctioned for that purpose. Renovation work of the roads are in progress viz. roads stretching from Madhupur to Konaban, N.C. Nagar to Barman Tilla, from Haribarodhula to Colony, from Madhupur to Pathariaduar, from

Sankartilla to Champamura and from Deendayal Chowmuhani to Fultali bazaar, reported the executive engineer of PWD.

On the other hand, boarding house for boys and girls will be constructed in Madhupur H.S. School. Representative of the rural development department informed that a dining hall has been constructed in Kalamchaura H.S. School utilizing the allotted fund of MGNREGA. Construction work of eight additional classrooms in eight schools of this district utilizing the fund of Minorities Welfare Scheme is in progress.
