MGNREGA: 1 lakh 76thousand person-days in Kadamtala block

A total of 1 lakh 76 thousand person-days have been generated under MGNREGA in 19 gram panchayats of Kadamtala Block during this current financial year from 1 April to 11 October. 10 thousand 850 persons from 8 thousand 484 families of this block have got work. An amount of Rs.3 crore 13 lakh 20 thousand 504 has been spent to implement this programme. Moreover, a total of 1 lakh 8 thousand 568 person-days have been generated under MGNREGA in 16 gram panchayats and 1 ADC village of Kalacherra block under Dharmanagar subdivision till 11 October of this current financial year. 8 thousand 52 persons from 6 thousand 658 families of this block have got work. An amount of Rs.1 crore 92 lakh 16 thousand 536 has been spent to implement this programme.
