461 health camps organized in Dhalai in the month of August

With a view to reaching out to the people of remote areas with health a total of 461 health camps were organized in different areas under 3 Sub-Divisional Hospitals, 2 CHCs and 16 PHCs of Dhalai District in the month of August during the current financial year. A total of 9074 patients were treated and necessary medicines were distributed among them in those 461 health camps. Blood test of 2618 patients was done by way of which malaria parasites were found in the blood of 155 patients. In those camps medical officers and health staff discussed on good health of mother and child, immunization of child in time, prevention of malaria and diarrhea and cleanliness of houses.
